

Cairo - Airport Assistance & Visa Service

Welcome to Cairo! Upon arrival, you will be met by your Travelous Airport Representative, who will aid and facilitate you through the Visa process (cost included). You will then be

Cairo - Airport (Arrival)

Bustling Cairo, "the city of a thousand minarets" is the largest in the Middle-East, groaning under the weight of over 20 million inhabitants. On its west side lies the capital of the Old Kingdom, Memphis, still hinting of ancient days of grandeur and triumph. On its east side lies the beautiful Garden City, with its lush, sprawling gardens and expansive ornamental palaces. Now a modern metropolis, Cairo is an utterly unique place that offers a vast array of monuments and activities appealing to every kind of visitor. From medieval markets to oriental dance shows and from Roman ruins to mighty Pyramids of Giza & Sphinx, there is never a dull moment in this city!

Pyramids of Dashur, Saqqara & Memphis (Lunch Included)

Today, you will be taken to Dahshur, which lies at 25-mile distance from Cairo.

Dahshur is a royal necropolis located in the desert on the west bank of the Nile. It is known chiefly for several pyramids, two of which are among the oldest, largest and best preserved in Egypt, built from 2613-2589 BC.

You will explore the Bent Pyramid and the Red Pyramid, which were constructed during the reign of Pharaoh Sneferu (2613-2589 BC), father of Khufu of the Old Kingdom. The shape of the Bent Pyramid is unique; it represents a transitional pyramid form believed to have been the result of an engineering crisis encountered during its construction. The Red Pyramid is the world's first true smooth-sided pyramid.

After a delicious lunch experiencing this area's ethnic cuisine, you're off again to Saqqara, the vast, ancient burial ground, which served as the necropolis for the Ancient Egyptian capital, Memphis. Your guide will provide a brief history of the famous Step Pyramid of Djoser and you will have free time to explore the area. Your final stop is Memphis, the ancient capital of Egypt. Here you will see artifacts from many of the great rulers of Egypt, including the huge fallen statue of Ramses II.

Saggara Inclusions: Tomb of Mehu and the Serapeum (This service is on a private basis.)

Entrance to Cheops Pyramid

Although only a limited number of people are allowed inside daily, your private Egyptologist will ensure entrance for you. Cheops is a must for any historical traveler.

Cairo - Pyramids of Giza & Sphinx (Lunch Included)

Get ready for an adventurous day exploring the vivacious city of Giza! After breakfast, you will embark on a full day tour with your private certified Egyptologist who will provide a fascinating introduction to each of the three famed pyramids of Giza.

After visiting the Great Pyramids, you will continue across the plateau for a photo opportunity of the pyramids rising from the sands, with the Cairo skyline in the background. A short drive to the city side of the plateau finds you standing at the feet of the Sphinx, the enigmatic symbol of Egypt for thousands of years.

Cairo - Aswan (1.5 hr)

Flight from Cairo to Aswan. The duration is 1.5 hours.

Aswan - Airport (Arrival)

Welcome to Aswan! Transfer in a private vehicle with English speaking driver from the Airport to your hotel.

Aswan is Egypt's southernmost city and arguably one of the most visually stunning in terms of its location and geography. Once the gateway to inner Africa and today as the last port of call for all Nile river cruises, Aswan is particularly known for its two dams and blended Nubian Culture. A city that truly gives you the feeling that you are in Africa as opposed to a desert land, highlights include the Aswan High Dam, Temple of Philae, the Unfinished Obelisk, Mausoleum of Aga Khan, St. Simeon's Monastery and Kalabsha Temple. Day 5: Unfinished Obelisk, Philae Temple (Lunch), Kitchener Island by Felucca

Aswan - Unfinished Obelisk & Philae Temple (Lunch)

Head to the Unfinished Obelisk, which was ordered by the longest-reigning female pharaoh, Hatshepsut, ruling the scene for over 22 years. The Obelisk was carved straight out of bedrock but it was quickly abandoned when large latent cracks were discovered on either side. This abandoned monument gives great insight into the stone-cutting techniques and tools used by the skilled ancient Egyptian workers.

Your next stop will be at the fascinating Temple of Philae, moved to the Island of Agilkia after the waters of Lake Nasser flooded its original location. Dedicated to the greatly-revered goddess Isis, the Temple attracted thousands of pilgrims yearly during ancient times. Now encircled by crystal blue waters and adorned with lush foliage, the Temple will draw you in to discover the secrets of a bygone era. Lunch served at Movenpick Aswan Hotel. (*This service is on a private basis.*)

Kitchener Island by Felucca & Botanical Garden

Explore Aswan by traditional felucca and sail to Kitchener Island. Take a stroll through the peaceful gardens that display an array of colorful species of plants and trees. Visit the botanical gardens and learn about plants that have been imported from the most remote and exotic places in the world. Optional: Stop at the Nubian Village. (*This service is on a private basis.*)

Kom Ombo

Visit the unique Temple of Kom Ombo. As you walk through the temple complex, take notice of the courts, halls, sanctuaries, and rooms which are duplicated for two sets of

gods. The southern half of the temple was dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek, god of fertility and creator of the world. Meanwhile, the northern part of the temple was dedicated to the falcon god Haroeris, also known as Horus the Elder. A few of the three hundred crocodile mummies discovered in the vicinity are displayed in The Crocodile Museum. Make sure to visit the strange instruments resembling surgical tools, located in the complex's southeast corner! (*This service is on a private basis.*)

Edfu

The city of Edfu houses the Ptolemaic Temple of Horus, built over a period of two thousand years. The inner walls of the building tell the mysterious story of Horus coming into existence. Horus was born upon his father's death, Osiris, the god of the underworld - killed by his brother, Seth. The much-beloved goddess Isis brought Horus into life from a piece of Osiris' flesh. Horus later battled Seth and won, but lost an eye in the process. Hence, the 'eye of Horus' has important religious symbolism in ancient Egyptian mythology.

The Temple of Edfu was abandoned as a religious monument following Theodosius I's edict, banning non-Christian worship within the Roman Empire. Many of the temple's carved reliefs were destroyed in the process. The blackened ceiling of the hypostyle hall, visible today, is believed to be the result of arson intended to destroy religious imagery considered pagan. Lunch at Mudhouse. Luxor - Hot Air Balloon Ride

Experience the sunrise high above the Valley of the Kings and Queens on a Hot Air Balloon ride. During the flight, you will have the opportunity to witness a panoramic view of the largest open-air museum on the planet that is Luxor. The flight time is approximately 45 minutes and a light breakfast is served. Please be ready to be picked up at 4.30 a.m.

Note: Only mobile phone camera is allowed to be used.

Luxor - West Bank (Lunch Included)

Visit the Valley of the Kings, where you will see the intact royal tombs of the Pharaohs. Then, visit the Valley of the Queens. Stop at the magnificent temple of Queen Hatshepsut at Deir El-Bahri and make your way towards the immense Colossi of Memnon. The Colossi of Memnon are two massive stone statues of Pharaoh Amenhotep III. For the past 3,400 years, they have stood in the Theban Necropolis, across the River Nile from Luxor's modern city. Your last stop will be at the Theban Necropolis, used for ritual burials during pharaonic times. Note: Lunch to be served at Marsam Restaurant. (*This service is on a private basis.*)

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Luxor - King Tut's Tomb

Visit the famous tomb of King Tutankhamen in conjunction with your West Bank day tour.

Luxor - Tomb of Nefertari

Also included as part of your West Bank day tour - the tomb of Nefertari - the favorite queen of Rameses II, was buried about 3,200 years ago in the most exquisitely decorated tomb in Egypt's Valley of the Queens. Discovered in 1904 by Italian explorer Ernesto Schiaparelli, the tomb had deteriorated to a disastrous extent when emergency consolidation began in 1986. The six-year conservation project of the GCI and the Egyptian Antiquities Organization was completed in 1992.

Luxor - Medinat Habu Temple

Visit Habu Temple on a private tour of Luxor's West Bank that explores fascinating ancient art and architecture. You will learn the stories behind the vivid paintings at Habu Temple, as well as tombs built for both workers and royalty. (This service is on a private basis.)

Luxor - Sunset Quad Bike

Enjoy the breathtaking scenery of ancient lands and Pharaohs by Quad Bike on this magical journey. Experience Egyptian history and explore a three million-year-old dry sea bed where you'll find fossilized sea creatures by the hundreds! Climb an ancient sea mountain covered in fossils of coral, lobsters, crabs, abalone and more upon the seafloor of a magnificent untouched valley. The tour begins from the majestic west bank desert behind Habu temple, then continues to a small mountain behind the Al Moudira hotel. Watch the sunset while sipping authentic Egyptian tea made by a local family while viewing breathtaking sand dunes. (*This service is on a private basis.*)


