- Passports must be valid for at least 6 months beyond the intended departure date and must have at least
 3 blank visa (not endorsement) pages.
- Visa is required to enter Tanzania and Kenya. Visa approvals are obtained via online application.
- ravelers must have sufficient funds to support themselves whilst in the country or entry into a country could be denied. The granting of a visa is not a guarantee of entry.
- Make extra copies of passports and airline tickets to take with you on your trip. Please ensure you keep these documents separate from the originals in the event of an emergency such as your passport getting lost or stolen.
- Should you fail to join or start your journey for any reason (i.e. airline delays or missed connections) the cancellation policy will apply. Adequate travel insurance is required.
- All guests are required to purchase comprehensive travel, medical, cancellation, curtailment and default insurance for the duration of your trip. Due to the remote areas through which you may travel, it is vital that all guests are covered for emergencies and other unforeseen circumstances. You become liable for cancellation penalties immediately on confirmation of booking services. We will not be held responsible for guests travelling without insurance.

HELPFUL REMINDERS

- Please ensure you read Alluring Africa's A-Z Guide located at the end of this booklet, which provides important information to help you prepare for your trip. If you have any questions, please contact your travel consultant.
- We recommend you call the airlines a few days before your departure to reconfirm flight times, as schedules may change.
- The recommended check-in times for all domestic scheduled flights are 2 hours prior to departure, and 3 hours for all regional and international scheduled flights.
- We always recommend you call the airlines directly to request seat assignments, special meals, wheelchair assistance at airports or anything you may need to make the flight portion of your trip as comfortable as possible.
- We strongly recommend that you read all our literature and if you have any questions to please contact us. Please be understanding about travel conditions, particularly in third world countries. Unexpected situations do arise; such as to inclement weather, irregular transport operations, strikes, etc. These are often unavoidable and beyond our control, however, we always strive to ensure safe operation of all our programs.
- Cell Phones, Internet, Satellite phones at Camps/Lodges: Many operators have made a conscious decision NOT to offer internet access for guests at their safari camps. This enables them to continue offering a natural wilderness experience, away from the stress of everyday life. If there is a problem/emergency, we are able to get messages to and from guests at camps, which we have been doing very successfully for many years. If you will be bringing a satellite or iridium phone with you on safari, please adhere to the following courtesies:
 - o Keep your ring tone at a low volume.
 - Please use your phone in the privacy of your room and not any of the common areas (i.e. dining areas or vehicles).
- **IMPORTANT:** Do not pack anything of high value (sentimental or financial) in your checked baggage. We cannot be held responsible for missing items. We recommend locking your luggage.

LIGHT AIRCRAFT TRANSFERS

Your journey includes shared light aircraft transfers (i.e. you will be flying with other guests unless private is specified) and which may entail stops.

- When we utilize shared air transfers, they are booked through licensed charter companies and may be sub-chartered.
- Inter-lodge flight transfer times are only arranged 24 hours in advance. The lodge or camp will ensure you are transferred by road to the airstrip in time for your flight.
- At certain times of the year it may be necessary (for safety reasons) to transfer you during the cooler times of the day.
- The aircraft type used for each transfer is determined by the charter operator and is based on the number of passengers booked on that day. The most commonly flown aircraft are single engine Cessna 206's (5 passengers), and Cessna Grand Caravan's (12 passengers). These aircraft are well suited because of their ability to carry large loads out of short airfields economically.
- African law does not require two pilots on the single engine aircraft flights used for our safaris.



- > Strict luggage and weight restrictions on light aircraft transfers exist because:
 - o Aircraft have a maximum body and luggage weight allowance, including space restrictions
 - Most airfields are over 3,500 feet above sea level and are located in the warm tropics, thereby reducing the permissible carrying capacity.
- Weight restrictions on charter flights are limited to a soft "barrel" (duffle bag) with a maximum of 33 lbs.
 This includes your day pack and camera gear. Weight limits are strictly enforced.
- Only soft bags, preferably without wheels, will be accepted. This includes camera equipment and hand luggage. Hard suitcases are not permitted.
- The maximum dimensions allowed are 10" W x 11" H x 24" L. Light aircraft baggage compartments are only 10" high, so the pilots must have the ability to manipulate the bag into the compartment.
- Important packing considerations:
 - Most accommodations provide basic toilet amenities.
 - o Laundry is done daily on a complimentary basis or for a nominal fee.
 - o Safari only requires casual clothing unless specified (i.e. for luxury train journeys, etc.)
 - o To further assist you in adhering to this luggage limit, a suggested packing list has been included within Alluring Africa's Pre-Departure information.
- Passengers weighing over 220 lbs. or two guests travelling together whose total weight is over 390 lbs. must notify us in advance, as an extra seat must be priced for safety purposes.







Enjoy two full days of game viewing activities at Jabali Ridge.


Ruaha National Park is renowned in East Africa for its excellent guides and truly wild landscape. Whether you're tracking lions by vehicle, discovering the smaller wonders on foot or just relaxing in camp, the expert guides at Jabali Ridge will enhance your wildlife experience with their superb knowledge.

Game drives: Guided game drives are offered twice a day. Our six-seater game-viewing vehicles are open-sided with a canvas roof and the canvas sides can be rolled down in case of rain (ponchos are provided). All vehicles have power points where you can recharge your devices, and all are fitted with fridges to keep your drinks deliciously frosty. A private game-viewing vehicle can be booked by prior arrangement. In the morning, maximise your game-viewing time by taking a delicious breakfast picnic with you to enjoy under the shade of a tree. In the evening, sip a cold gin & tonic in the heart of the bush as the sun sinks below the horizon.

Night drives: When the sun descends, the elusive night animals come out to play. Explore the secrets of these shy creatures on a night game drive through Ruaha National Park.



Upon arrival at **Ikuu Airstrip**, you will be met by a **camp vehicle** and transferred to **Chada Katavi where you will stay for three nights.**

Time permitting, enjoy lunch and and afternoon activity.

KATAVI NATIONAL PARK

Enjoy two full days of game viewing activities at Chada Katavi.

Wildlife abounds in this remote corner of Tanzania. Incredible landscapes, where even seeing another vehicle is unlikely. Katavi National Park is home to a plethora of wildlife. Here guests can view vast herds of buffalo, elephants, and an assortment of stealthy predators. Adventures include twice-daily game drives in open 4×4 safari vehicles, bush walks with an armed guide and fly camping which will take guests to the heart of Katavi's untamed wilderness.

Be adventurous and spend the night out in the bush on an exhilarating fly camp adventure. Get up-close to the wildlife of Katavi on an informative walking safari.

Little has changed at Chada Katavi since the Nomad Tanzania founders arrived 20 years ago. From the air you have to look carefully to spot it, you'll find your eyes are immediately drawn to such wide-open spaces. That's the promise of Katavi, total absorption into the natural world.


Mahale Airstrip to Greystoke Mahale

After the morning activity (time permitting) and breakfast, you will be transferred by a **camp vehicle** to Ikuu Airstrip for your scheduled charter flight to Mahale. Upon arrival, you will be **met and transferred by boat** to **Greystoke Mahale, where you will stay for four nights.**

Time permitting, enjoy lunch and an afternoon activity.

Overnight: Greystoke Mahale - Double Room

Included: All meals, drinks (except champagne & premium wines); laundry; activities on a shared basis: chimp trekking, boat trips, deep water swims, forest walks; scheduled boat transfers to/from Mahale airstrip for Nomad Shared Charter flights and Safari Airlink schedule flights.



DAYS 9 - 11: FRI, JUL 16 - SUN, JUL 18

MAHALE NATIONAL PARK

Enjoy three full days of game viewing activities at Greystoke Mahale.

CHIMPANZEE TRACKING

The main quest is always on foot to a wild living group of chimpanzees, whose complex social and political maneuverings are played out within a few feet of us. Their behavior is interpreted by their greatest fans, our team of chimpanzee experts who can recognize each individual and the significance of every action. The dry season in Mahale starts in June, when the long rains have stopped, and goes through to October. At this time of year the temperatures increase and the skies are quite hazy, the lake has never been more appealing for a cooling dip. As the dry season progresses, the chimps are more usually found in the lower slopes due to their favorite fruits being found lower down.

LAKE TANGANYIKA

This lake is a phenomenal natural habitat for us to explore. But we also pleasure-seek here, unashamedly: kayaking towards the Congo at sunrise, the unsurpassable feeling of diving off the dhow into its sunset waters and watching hippos moonwalk through the depths.

UNDER THE CANOPY

On winding forest trails, our guides show life beyond the chimpanzees; eight other species of primate alone, insects unseen elsewhere, a pharmacopeia of medicinal plants. Often you get just a flash of what's in the shadows: the silhouette of a red-tail monkey, the scarlet wing of a turaco, the neon of a beetle's back.



TO THE VILLAGE

Get the feel of a Tanganyika village and see the work of the Nomad Trust, with a visit to Katumbi on the park boundary. You can call in at the primary school, where we have built and furnished classrooms and installed solar power, and the community clinic, where we fund vital healthcare from first aid and midwifery.

It's no exaggeration to say there is nowhere in the world like Greystoke Mahale. Greystoke Mahale sits on a pristine, white sandy beach overlooking the turquoise water of Lake Tanganyika, with the forested slopes of the 8000 ft Mahale Mountains rising behind.

Time permitting, enjoy lunch and an afternoon activity.

DAY 14: WED, JUL 21

AMBOSELI NATIONAL PARK

Enjoy one full day of game viewing activities at Tortilis Camp.

Dominated by the snow cap of Mount Kilimanjaro, Amboseli is known for its magnificent elephants a population of over 1,000 elephants reside in the park's ecosystem that features some of the largest in Africa. Game drives, walks, sundowners and bush meals all take place both inside the Amboseli National Park and within a private 30,000-acre game concession, offering fantastic game viewing opportunities.

The Tortilis Camp guides are based at camp in Amboseli and know their backyard intimately. They know the individual elephants and their family histories. More than half of the guides at Tortilis are Masai and have between them 80 years of guiding at Tortilis! Open gamedrive vehicles are designed specifically for comfort and photography – open sided with 3 rows of seats, photographic equipment stands, and charging sockets. Guests will share game drives unless "exclusive use of vehicle" has been prebooked at an extra charge. With only 10% of Amboseli National Park utilized by most safari vehicles, combined with Tortilis Camp's unique location on the western edge of the park, guests can enjoy an almost private Amboseli. There is also private game driving within the camp's 30,000-acre Kitirua Conservancy, which is the western part of the Amboseli ecosystem.



DAYS 16 & 17: FRI, JUL 23 - SAT, JUL 24

LAIKIPIA

Enjoy two full days of game viewing activities at El Karama.

The wildlife experience here is world—class, offering abundant daily sightings of the Big 4, incredible bird life, stunning landscapes to walk, drive, explore and sleep in under the stars. Interactive conservation projects for guests to be involved here in include El Karama Lodge's unique Leopard Mirror Project, Lion behavior research and monitoring through Lion Landscapes and a lodge -funded Reforestation and Seed Bank Project for the Acacia Nilotica tree species and of course Laikipia's first Bush School for kids!

This precious habitat supports over 431 verified bird species and Northern mammals such as Grevy's Zebra, Gerenuk and Vulterine Guinea Fowl. With outstanding views of natural beauty including a spectacular waterfall, mixed habitat and direct views of Mount Kenya; guests can wake up to the peaks of Kenya's most exciting climbing peak and fall asleep to the sounds of the mighty Ewaso Nyiro river and hippo grunting!



Activities at El Karama:

- Bush School for kids: activities to engage and educate young minds on safari.
- Guided walking activities including full day adventures ending at the waterfall or river.
- Game drives and Night Drives with wildlife friendly spotlights.
- Wildlife viewing hide for photographers next to a large dam and wetland.
- Private fly camping experiences under the stars with open fire cooking
- Fishing, Tracking, Farm visits.
- Interactive Wildlife and Conservation Activities.
- Farm to fork dining: visit the organic garden, orchard and working farm.
