



AIRPORT SECURITY REGULATIONS:

In accordance with security regulations imposed by the TSA, the following measures are being implemented at Mexico City's International Airport:

- At the airline counters all passengers must specify where they're traveling to, regardless of whether they're flying first, business, or economy class.
- If traveling to the USA, passengers must present their passport, tourist card, residence permit, and/or visa; as the case may be.
- Passengers shall be assigned an interviewer, who will ask a few random questions. This will take
 around one or two minutes per interviewee. People traveling together shall be interviewed
 separately. Questions will mainly be about a passenger's professional life, hobbies, reasons for
 travel, and if the passenger is a US citizen— about their stay in Mexico (hotel where they
 stayed, places visited, marital status, if they have family in Mexico, etc.)
- In case the interviewer gives his approval, he shall place a sticker on the passenger's passport, verifying that the passenger has been interviewed and may board the plane. If the passport doesn't have the sticker, the passenger won't be able to board the plane and will have to find an interviewer at the gate.
- Passengers traveling with carry-on luggage shall go to the counter for their interview to obtain the passport sticker.

• If the interviewer is not satisfied by the passenger's answers, the passenger shall proceed to another interview with the airport's immigration staff. As of now, it is unknown what this procedure would entail.

Points 3 to 6 are currently only being carried out by United and Delta Airlines; however, all airlines are expected to implement these measures soon.

Because of these new regulations, some airlines (like United) will no longer allow our Airport Supervisor to accompany our clients to the counter. Our clients will have to check-in on their own. Please be advised to be at the airport at least three hours before your flight for any inconvenience.

The authorities also released a notice informing passengers that in accordance with security regulations imposed by the TSA for flights to the US, all electronic devices bigger than a smartphone will be subject to an additional and specific inspection conducted by the airline, prior to boarding the airplane.

PRACTICAL INFORMATION:

Pricing Policy: Please note, all proposals that include accommodation enjoy a 15% discount on non accommodation services. Change Fees: Prices are subject to change until full payment is received. Once deposit is received Journey Mexico assesses a per person charge of \$50 per change or cancelation until 30 days prior to travel. 29 days or less prior to travel Journey Mexico assesses a per person charge of \$100 per person per change.

Credit Cards: We gladly accept American Express, Visa and Mastercard and will request you to fill out a Credit Card Authorization form or pay via a secure link that we will provide. Please be aware that we charge a 3.5% service fee for using a credit card.

Cancellations and Refunds: If it becomes necessary for you to cancel your trip, the following fees will apply computed as of the date of receipt of written cancellation notice.

Cancellation Fee Schedule*: All Cancellations must be received in writing.

Minimum fee: Your Initial Deposit is non-refundable.

- 61 days or more prior to arrival: All non-refundable deposits, surcharges and deposits will be charged.
- 60-31 days prior to arrival: All non-refundable deposits, surcharges and deposits will be charged, a cancellation fee of 50% of the entire trip cost will be charged.
- 30 days or less: 100% of trip cost will be charged.
