Kraft paper

How-to

 Start by looking at a sweater for inspiration.
Using a pen, copy a simple pattern to the rubber block.
Use your carver to carve away the negative space around your pattern.
Test it on paper to see what you have to carve away.
Once you are happy with your stamp, use it on kraft paper to create your own sweater pattern.

How-to

1. Take a photo of your sweater. Transfer the image to your computer.

2. Print your image. Be sure to select "fit to paper" in the print options so that your image fills up the full piece of paper.

4. Trim off the white edges of your paper and wrap your gift.
