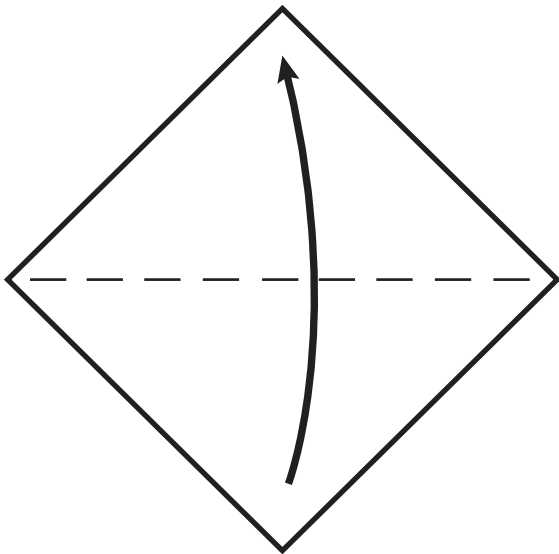
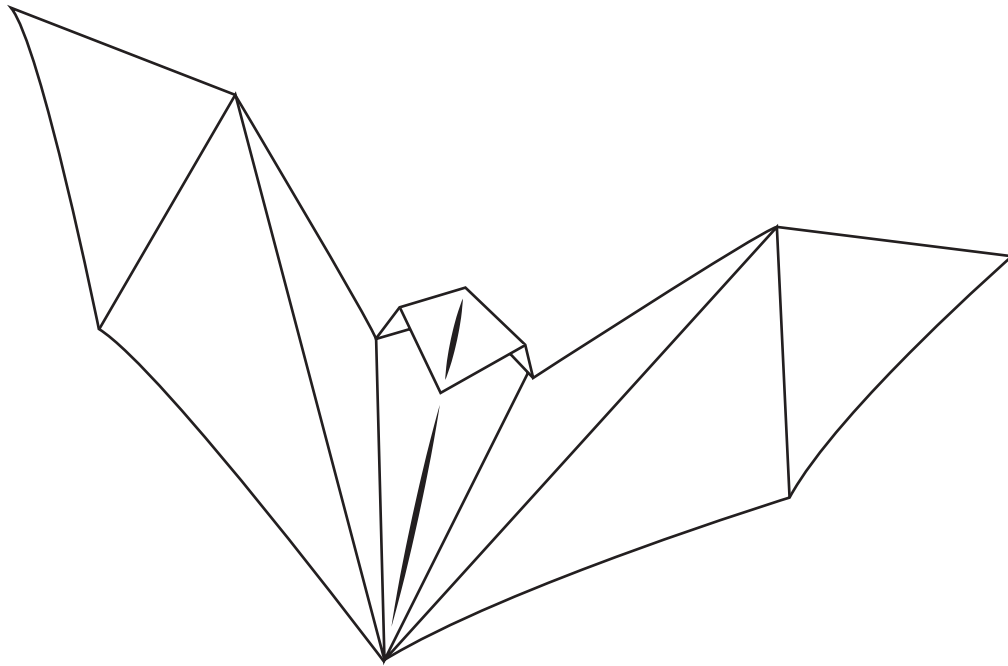
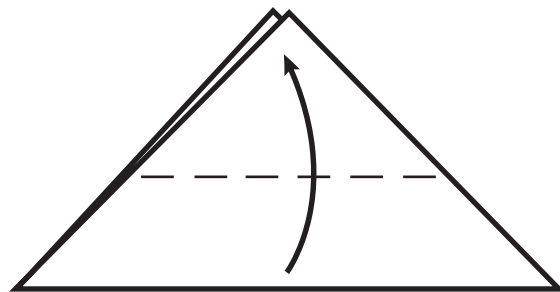

free origami bat template!

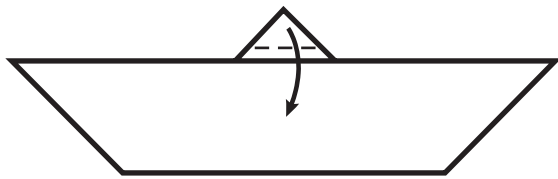
This design by Nick Robinson makes it easy to fold a handful of flying bats from origami paper. Make a flock to attach to a wreath for a creepy Halloween welcome.



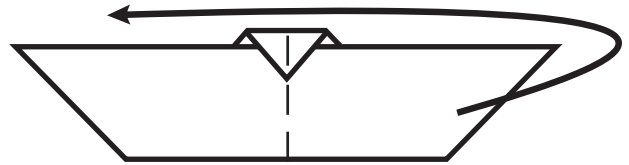
1. Start with a square piece of origami paper. Fold square in half diagonally.



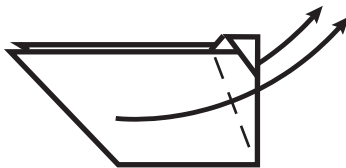
2. Fold bottom edge up to form a boat shape.



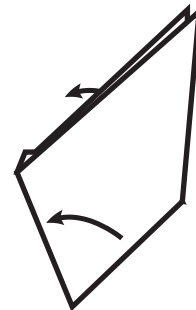
3. Fold tip down to create a head. Don't fold flush against the bottom, but leave a small space (as shown) to create the appearance of ears.



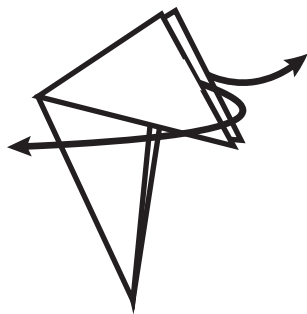
4. Bring edges together at the back.



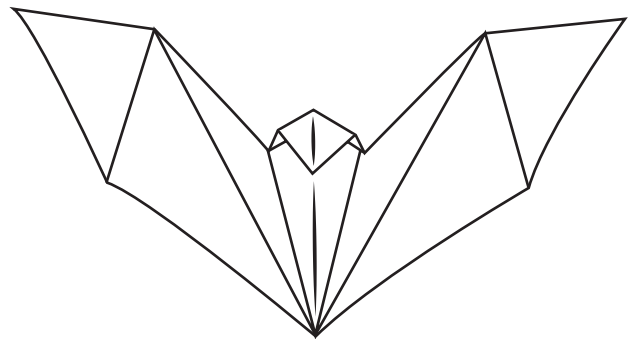
5. Fold edges up so they meet.



6. Bring edges together at the back.



7. Fold top edges down, at an angle, with tips meeting. Unfold to see bat shape.



8. Make desired number of origami bats and attach to wreath.
