

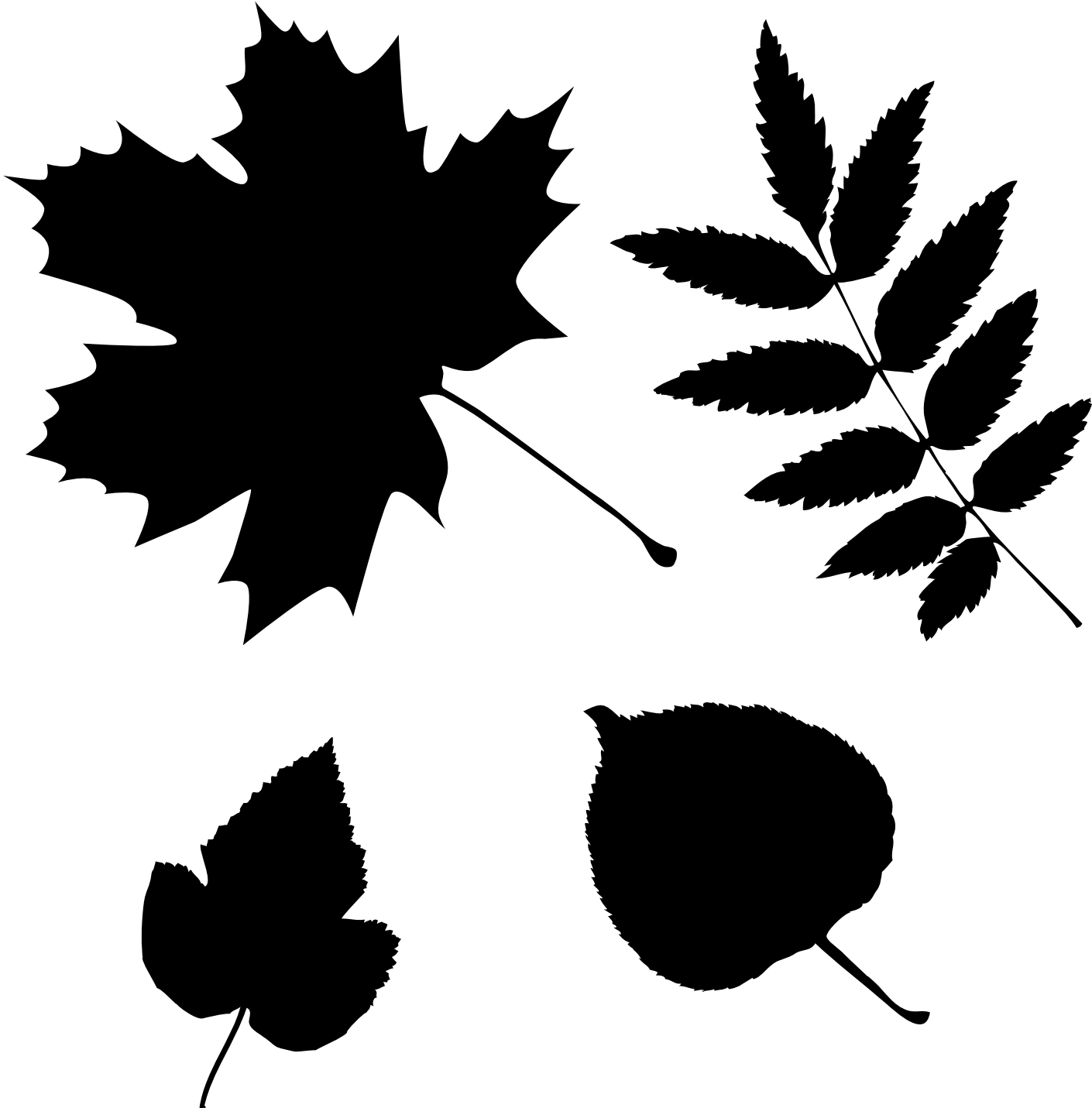
Tree Pattern for Pumpkins

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALL PATTERNS

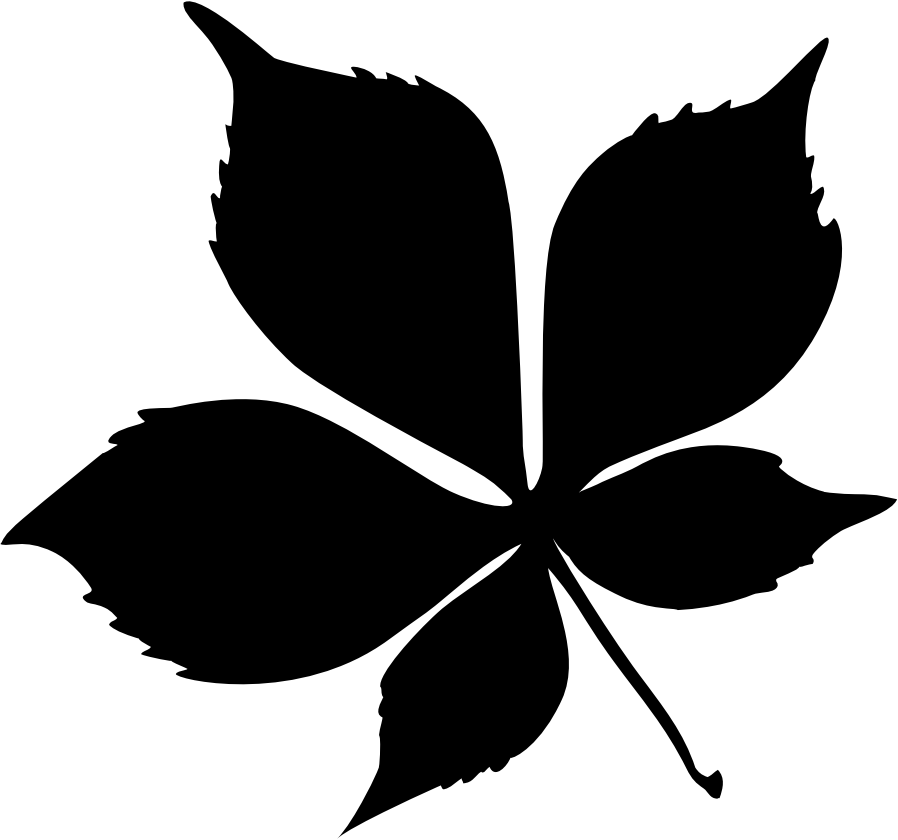
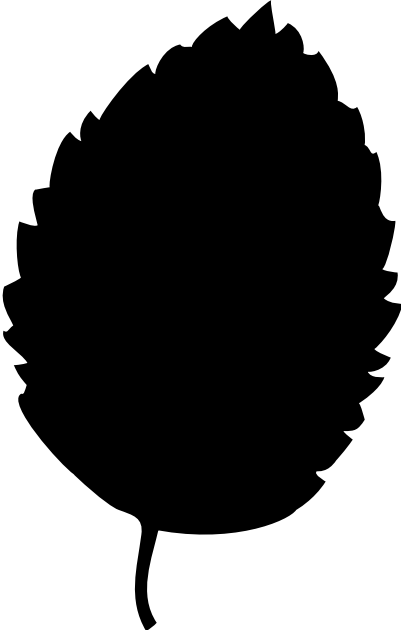
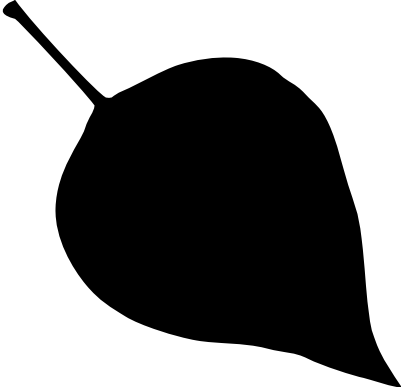
1. Cut a 9½ x12-inch piece of tissue paper that is the same color as the pumpkin.
2. Fold tissue paper over the edges of an 8½x11-inch piece of card stock.
3. Secure tissue paper to the back of card stock with tape.
4. Load card stock—tissue side up—into your printer’s paper tray. Print pattern. Use multiple sheets of tissue paper if needed.
5. Cut ¼ inch around the pattern and then remove the card stock.
6. Brush Outdoor Mod Podge on the pumpkin where the pattern will be applied.
7. Apply tissue-paper pattern to pumpkin, piecing pattern together as needed.
8. Apply a coat of Outdoor Mod Podge to the entire pumpkin to seal the pattern.
9. Let dry.



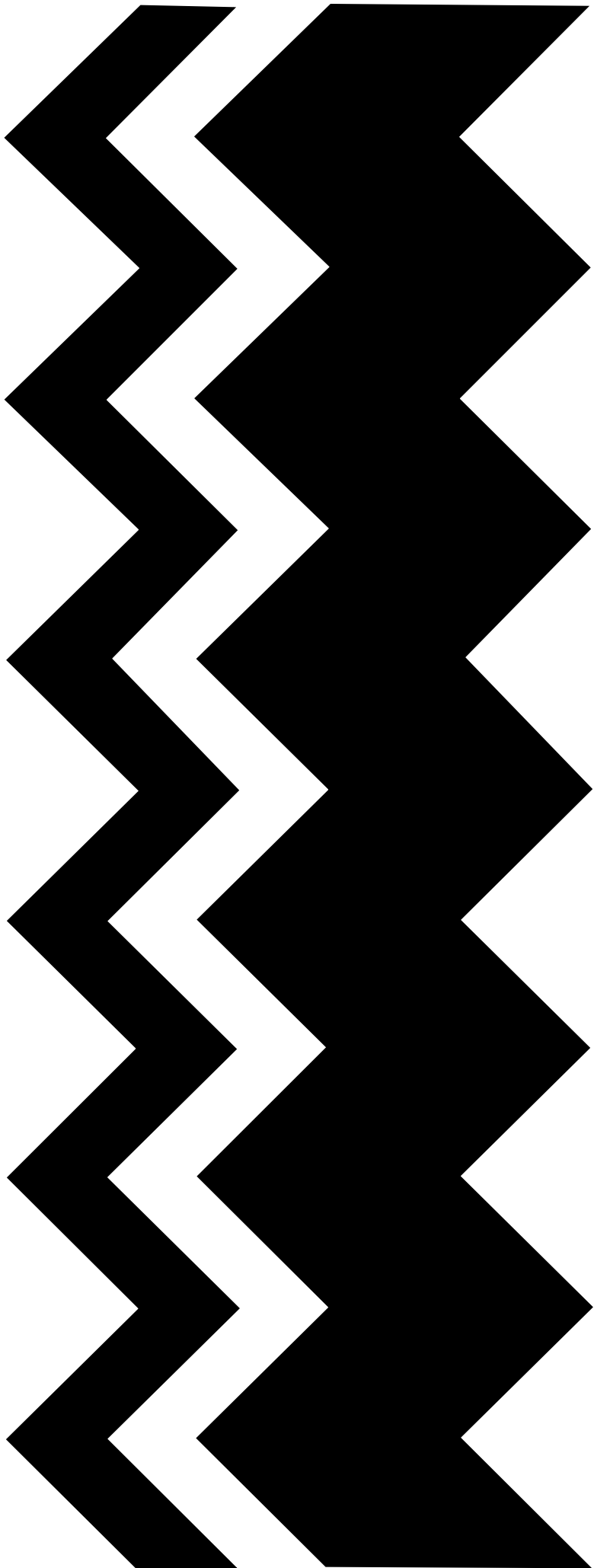

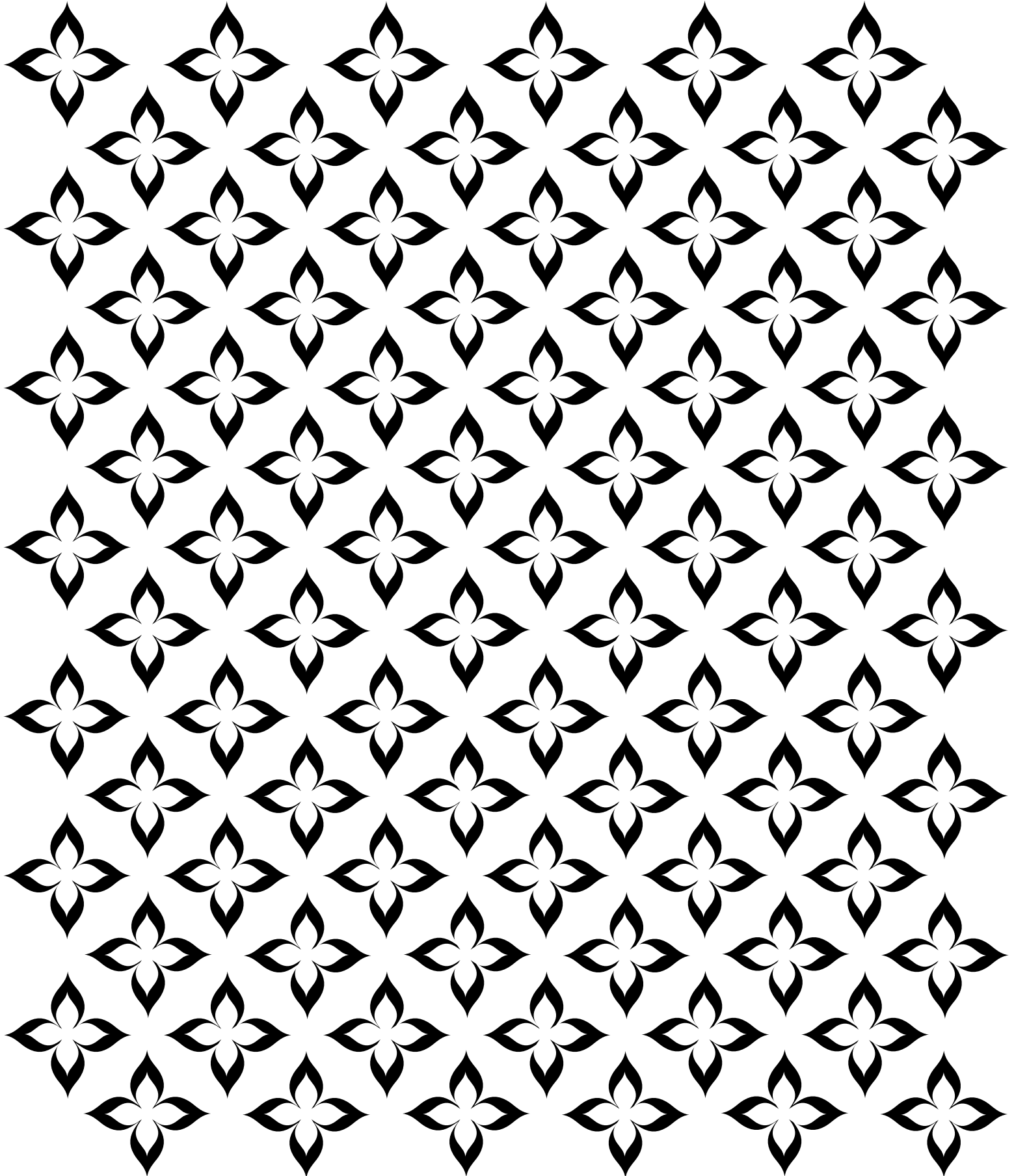
Leaf Patterns for Pumpkins



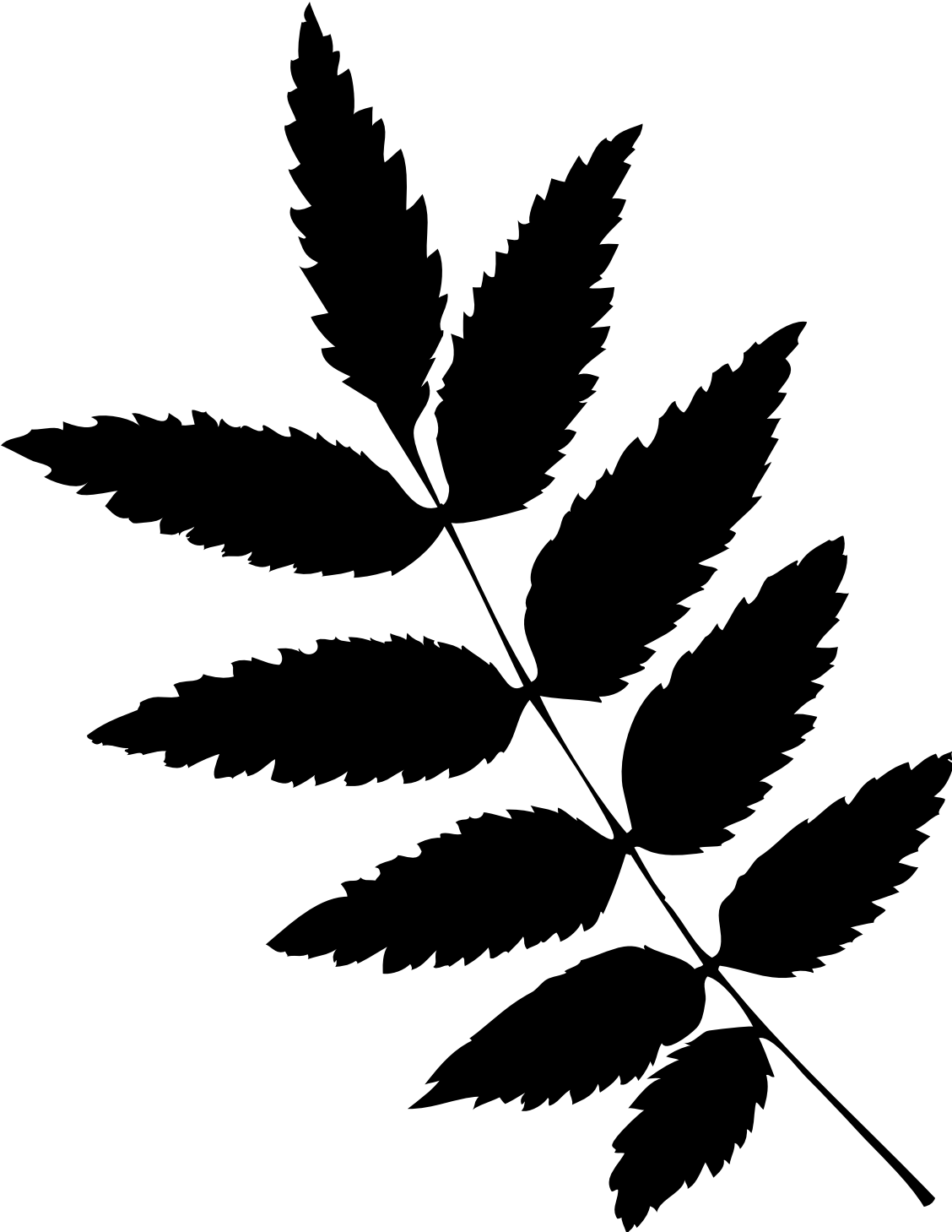
Chevron Pattern for Pumpkins



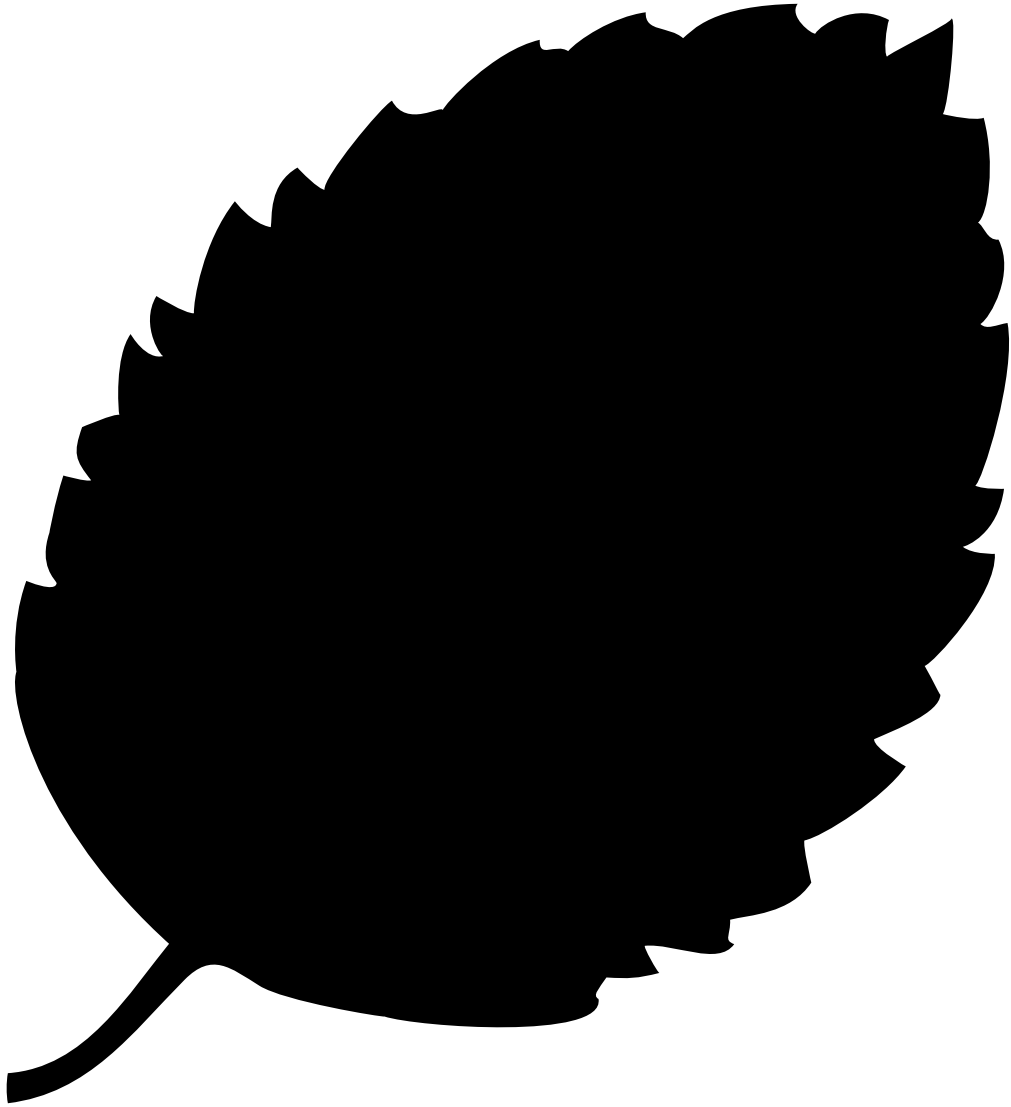
Diamond Pattern for Pumpkins



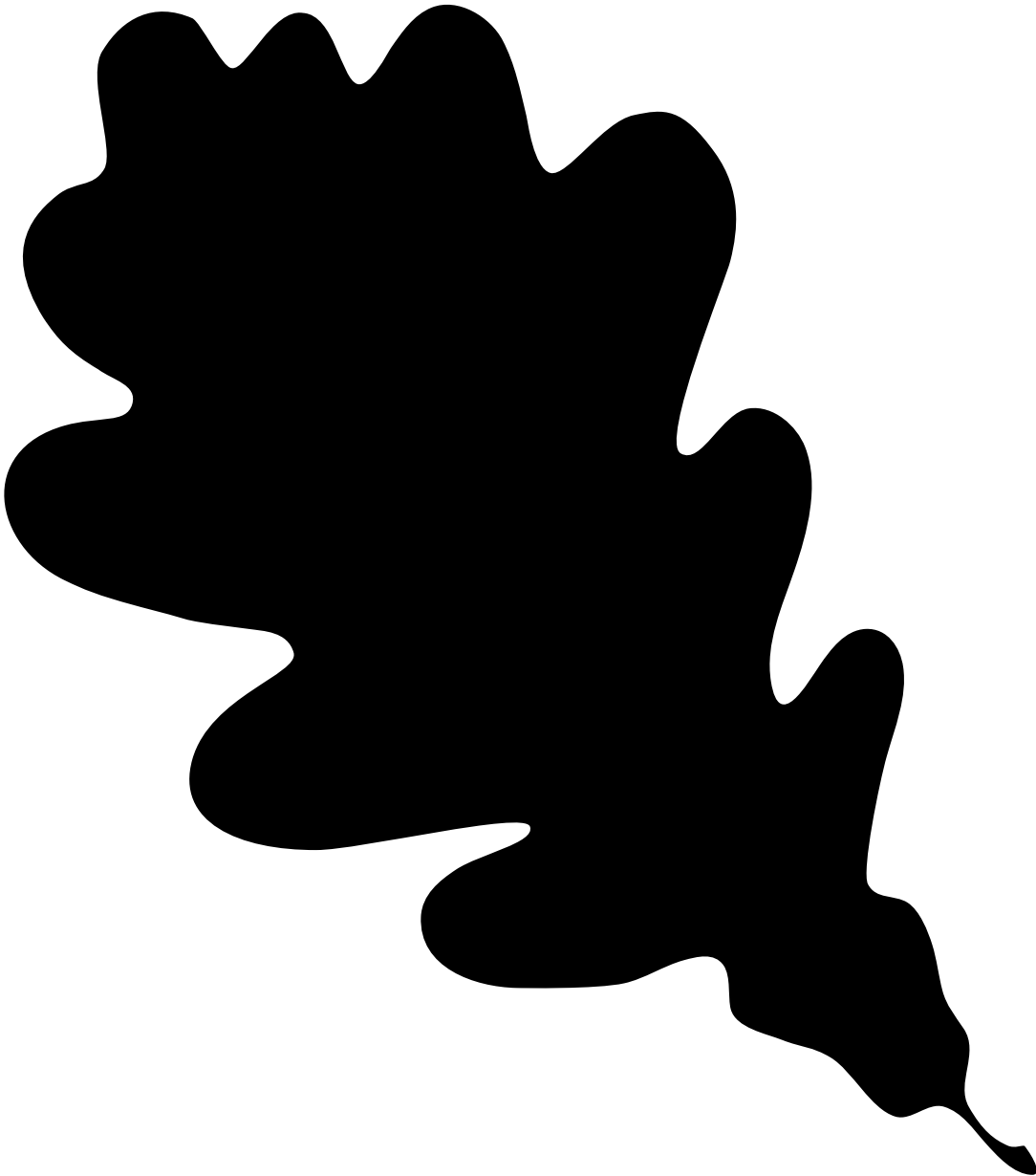
Large Leaf Pattern for Pumpkins
