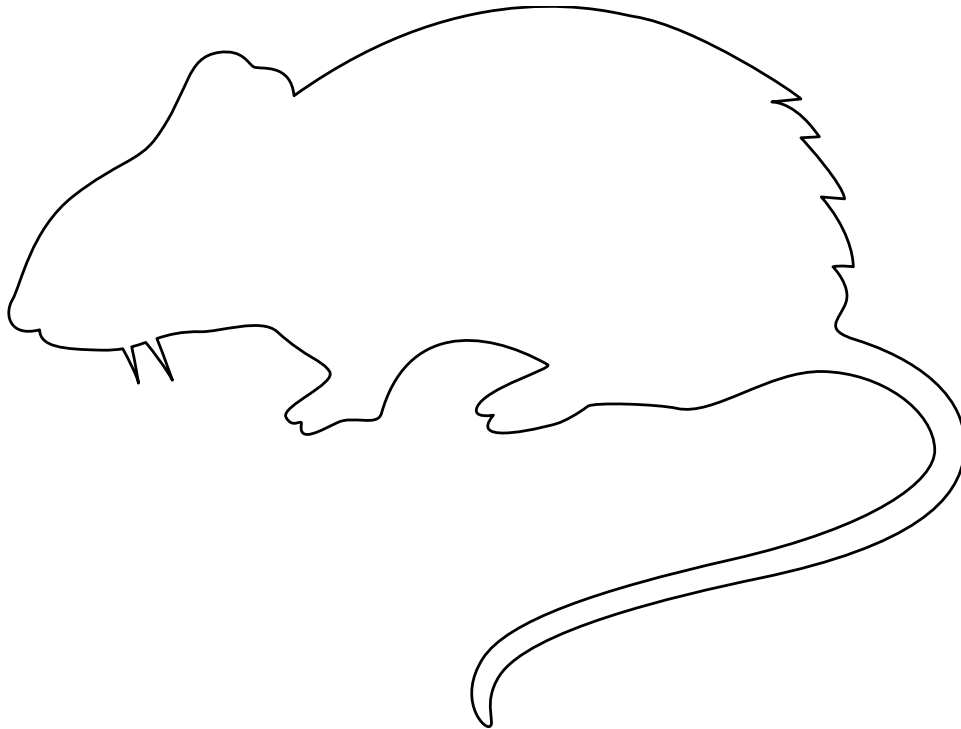


Mouse Stencil

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Print template, enlarging or reducing the pattern to fit your pumpkin.
2. If using a real pumpkin, hollow and clean it out. When using a foam pumpkin, such as a Funkin, clean the outside.
3. Create a stencil by cutting out and discarding each shape from the pattern with a crafts knife such as a X-acto.
4. Attach the stencil to the pumpkin with painter's tape.
5. Trace inside the cutouts with a washable marker.
6. Remove the stencil. (If you don't like the look, simply wipe off the lines and start again.)
7. Using a small brush and black acrylic paint, paint the mouse.
