MATERIALS

- 1½ yards solid white (blocks, setting and corner triangles)
- 26—precut 10" squares assorted medium and dark prints (blocks)
- 13—precut 10" squares assorted cream prints (blocks)
- 5⁄8 yard green print (sashing, binding)
- 7⁄8 yard cream floral (sashing, inner border)
- 7⁄8 yard yellow print (outer border)
- 37⁄8 yards backing fabric
- 68"-square batting
- 12"-square acrylic ruler

CUT FABRICS

Cut pieces in the following order.

From solid white, cut:

- 2–17¾" squares, cutting each diagonally twice in an X for 8 large setting triangles total
- 2–10" squares, cutting each in half diagonally for 4 large corner triangles total
- 26–4½" squares, cutting each diagonally twice in an X for 104 small setting triangles total
- 26–2⅝" squares, cutting each in half diagonally for 52 small corner triangles total
- 156–3" squares
