CUT FABRICS

Cut pieces in the following order.

From solid white, cut:

- 20–12½" setting squares
- 25–7¼" squares
- 120–4" squares, cutting each in half diagonally for 240 triangles total
- 84–3½×6½" rectangles
- 64–1½×3½" rectangles
- 64–2½" squares
- 64–1½×2½" rectangles

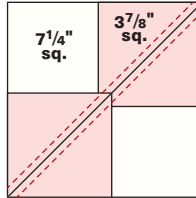

From solid pink, cut:

- Enough 2½"-wide bias strips to total 425" in length for binding
- 25–6½" sashing squares
- 60–4¾" squares
- 100–3⅞" squares
- 144–2½" squares

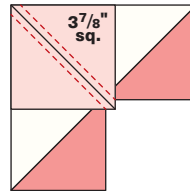

ASSEMBLE SASHING UNITS

2. Use a pencil to mark a diagonal line on wrong side of each solid pink 3⅞" square.

3. Referring to **Diagram 5**, align two marked solid pink squares with opposite corners of a solid white 7¼" square. Sew a scant ¼" from drawn lines on both sides of lines. Cut apart on drawn lines to make two triangle units (**Diagram 6**); press open.
