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Project: Chevron Band Pillowcase



FABRICS are from the Lavinia, Polygon, and Kiss Dot collections, all from Michael Miller Fabrics (michaelmillerfabrics.com).

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#### Materials

- 1/3 yard print No. 1 (band)
- 1/3 yard print No. 2 (band)
- 1/4 yard print No. 3 (band)
- 7/8 yard print No. 4 (pillowcase body)

Finished pillowcase: 30×20" (fits a standard-size bed pillow)

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

Measurements include ¼" seam allowances for piecing blocks and ½" seam allowances for pillowcase construction. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise specified.

#### **Cut Fabrics**

From print No. 1, cut:

- 40-2**½**" squares
- From print No. 2, cut:
- 20—2**1/**<sub>2</sub>×5**1/**<sub>2</sub>" rectangles

From print No. 3, cut:

- 1-5½×40½" strip
- From print No. 4, cut:
- 1—25**¾**"×41" rectangle

#### Assemble Blocks

Use a ¼" seam allowance for the following steps.

- Use a pencil to mark a diagonal line on wrong side of each print 2½" square.
- 2. Align a marked 2½" square with one end of a print 2½×5½" rectangle (Diagram 1; note direction of drawn line). Sew on marked line, then trim seam allowances to ¼". Press open attached triangle.

- 3. Align a marked 2½" square with opposite end of Step 2 rectangle (Diagram 2). Stitch, trim, and press as before to make a Segment A. The segment should be 5½×2½" including seam allowances.
- **4.** Repeat steps 2 and 3 to make 10 A segments total.
- 5. Repeat steps 2 and 3, referring to Diagrams 3 and 4 (note direction of drawn lines), to make a Segment B. The segment should be 5½×2½" including seam allowances. Repeat to make 10 B segments total.

#### Assemble Bands

Use a ¼" seam allowance for the following steps.

- 1. Join A segments and B segments in a row (Band Assembly Diagram). Press seams in one direction. The row should be 40½×5½" including seam allowances.
- 2. Sew together print 5½×40½" rectangle and block row along a pair of long edges.
- **3.** Join short edges of Step 2 unit to make a loop. Fold loop in half with wrong side inside; press to make pillowcase band.

#### Assemble Pillowcase

1. Fold print 25¾×41" rectangle in half to form a 25¾×20½" rectangle. Using a ½" seam allowance, sew together long edges and a pair of short edges to make pillowcase body. Turn right side out and press flat.

- 2. Matching raw edges, slide pillowcase band over pillowcase body with pieced units facing pillowcase body (Diagram 5); pin. Using a 1/4" seam allowance, sew together through all layers.
- Press pillowcase band open, pressing seam allowance toward pillowcase body. Topstitch 1/8" from band edge on pillowcase body to secure seam allowance and complete pillowcase (Diagram 6).

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
