# Project: Sawtooth Star Band

### Materials

- For one pillowcase:
- 8—1⁄4 yard total assorted prints (blocks)
- 1/4 yard black print (blocks)
- 1 yard cupcake print (pillowcase body, band)

Finished pillowcase: 30×20" (fits a standard-size bed pillow) Finished block: 5" square

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

Measurements include ¼" seam allowances for piecing blocks and pillowcase construction. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

# **Cut Fabrics**

#### From each assorted print, cut:

- 1—3" square
- 8—1¾" squares
- From black print, cut:
- 32—1¾× 3" rectangles
- 32—1**¾**" squares
- From cupcake print, cut:
- 1—251⁄2×401⁄2" rectangle
- 1—5<sup>1</sup>⁄<sub>2</sub>×40<sup>1</sup>⁄<sub>2</sub>" rectangle

### Assemble Sawtooth Star Blocks

- Gather eight matching assorted print 1¾" squares and four black print 1¾×3" rectangles.
- Mark a diagonal line on wrong side of each assorted print 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" square.
- Align a marked assorted print 1¾" square with one end of a black print 1¾×3" rectangle (Diagram 1; note direction of drawn line.) Sew on drawn line. Trim excess fabric, leaving ¼" seam allowance. Press open attached triangle. Align

a second marked assorted print 1¾" square with opposite end of rectangle. Stitch, trim, and press as before to make a Flying Geese unit. The unit still should be 3×1¾" including seam allowances. Repeat to make four Flying Geese units.

- Referring to Diagram 2, lay out four Flying Geese units, four black print 1¾" squares, and one matching assorted print 3" square in three horizontal rows. Sew together pieces in each row. Press seams away from Flying Geese units. Join rows to make a Sawtooth Star block. Press seams in one direction. The block should be 5½" square including seam allowances.
- 5. Repeat steps 1–4 to make eight Sawtooth Star blocks total.

## Assemble Band

- Sew together eight Sawtooth Star blocks in a row to make a 5½×40½" Sawtooth Star strip.
- Referring to Band Assembly Diagram, sew together Sawtooth Star strip and cupcake print 5<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>×40<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strip.
- Join short ends of Step 2 unit to make a loop. Press seam open. Fold loop in half with wrong side inside; press to make pillowcase band.

## Assemble Pillowcase

 Fold cupcake print 25<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>×40<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" rectangle in half crosswise to form a 25<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>×20<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" rectangle. Sew together long edges and one pair of short edges to make a pillowcase body. Turn right side out and press flat.

- Referring to Diagram 3, slide pillowcase band over pillowcase body with Sawtooth Star blocks facing pillowcase body; align raw edges and pin. Using 1/4" seam allowance, sew together through all layers.
- Press pillowcase band open, pressing seam allowances toward pillowcase body. Topstitch on pillowcase body ½8" from band seam (Diagram 4) to secure seam allowances and complete pillowcase.



BAND ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM


