

PROJECT: Hocus-Pocus Table Runner

Your stash of Halloween novelty fabrics will disappear when you create a spooky table topper.

FABRICS are from the Midnight Magic collection by April Rosenthal of Prairie Grass Patterns for Moda Fabrics *(modafabrics.com)*.



FINISHED TABLE RUNNER: 221/2×381/2" FINISHED BLOCK: 8" square

MATERIALS

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

- □ ¹/₂ yard total assorted white prints (blocks)
- □ 10" square *each* orange star print, black star print, orange candy corn print, gray print, light orange print, and medium orange print (blocks)
- □ 9×21" piece (fat eighth) each black candy corn print and mottled dark orange (blocks)
- □ ⁵/₈ yard black floral (blocks, outer border)
- □ ¹/₄ yard mottled black (inner border)
- □ ³/₈ yard orange floral (binding)
- □ 1¹/₃ yards backing fabric
- □ 31x47" batting

CUT FABRICS

Cut pieces in the following order.

If you prefer to make trianglesquares larger than necessary and trim them to size, cut 3" squares instead of the 21/8" squares specified here.

From assorted white prints, cut:

□ 36-2**7/8**" squares

From orange star print, cut:

□ 8-2**7/8**" squares

From black star print, cut:

 \Box 4-2⁷/8" squares

From orange candy corn print, cut: □ 6-2**7/8**" squares

From black candy corn print, cut: □ 12-2¹/2" squares

From black floral, cut:

- □ 20-2**7/8**" squares
- \Box 2-2¹/₂×34¹/₂" outer border strips
- \Box 2-2¹/₂×22¹/₂" outer border strips
- \Box 4-2¹/2" squares

From gray print, cut: □ 8-2**7/8**" squares

From light orange print, cut: □ 8-2**7/8**" squares

From medium orange print, cut: \Box 6–2⁷/8" squares

From mottled dark orange, cut: □ 16-2¹/₂" squares

From mottled black, cut:

 \square 2–1¹/₂×32¹/₂" inner border strips \square 2–1¹/₂×18¹/₂" inner border strips

From orange floral, cut: \Box 4-2¹/₂×42" binding strips

ASSEMBLE BLOCKS

Measurements include 1/4" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Press seams in directions indicated by arrows on diagrams. If no direction is specified, press seam toward darker fabric.

Use a pencil to mark a diagonal line on wrong side of each assorted white print 21/8" square, each orange star print 27/8" square, and each black star print 27/8" square.

2 Layer a marked white square atop an orange candy corn 27/8" square. Sew together with two seams, stitching 1/4" on each side of marked line (Diagram 1). Cut apart on marked line. Press open to make two trianglesquares. Each triangle-square should be 2¹/2" square including seam allowances. Repeat to make 12 white-and-orangecandy-corn triangle-squares total.

Repeat Step 2 using remaining marked and unmarked 27/8" squares to make triangle-squares in the following combinations. Press seams toward darker fabric.

- □ 40 white print and black floral
- □ 16 orange star print and gray print
- □ 8 black star print and light orange print
- □ 12 white print and medium orange print
- □ 8 light orange print and white print

4 Referring to **Diagram 2**, lay out the following pieces in four rows. Sew together pieces in rows. Join rows to make Block A. The block should be 8¹/2" square including seam allowances. Repeat to make four A blocks total.

- □ 3 white-and-orange-candy-corn triangle-squares
- □ 6 white-and-black-floral trianglesquares
- \square 2 black candy corn 2¹/₂" squares
- \square 2 mottled dark orange 2¹/₂" squares
- □ 2 orange-star-and-gray trianglesquares
- □ 1 black-star-and-light-orange triangle-square

Referring to Diagram 3, lay out the following pieces in four rows. Sew together pieces in rows. Join rows to make Block B. The block should be 8¹/2" square including seam allowances. Repeat to make two B blocks total.

- \square 1 black candy corn 2¹/₂" square
- □ 4 white-and-black-floral trianglesquares
- □ 3 white-and-medium-orange triangle-squares
- □ 2 mottled dark orange 2¹/2" squares
- □ 2 orange-star-and-gray trianglesquares
- □ 2 light-orange-and-white trianglesquares
- □ 1 black-star-and-light-orange triangle-square
- □ 1 black floral 2¹/₂" square

Referring to Diagram 4, lay out the following pieces in four rows. Sew together pieces in rows. Join rows to make Block C. The block should be 8¹/2" square including seam allowances. Repeat to make two C blocks total.

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- □ 3 white-and-medium-orange triangle-squares
- □ 4 white-and-black-floral trianglesquares
- $\hfill\square$ 1 black candy corn 21/2" square
- $\hfill\square$ 2 mottled dark orange 21/2 " squares
- 2 light-orange-and-white trianglesquares
- 2 orange-star-and-gray trianglesquares
- \Box 1 black floral 2¹/2" square
- 1 black-star-and-light-orange triangle-square

ASSEMBLE TABLE RUNNER TOP

1 Referring to **Table Runner** Assembly Diagram, arrange blocks in two rows. Sew together blocks in rows. Press seams in opposite directions.

2 Join rows to make table runner center. Press seams in one direction. The table runner center should be 16½×32½" including seam allowances.

Sew mottled black 1¹/₂×32¹/₂" inner border strips to long edges of table runner center (**Table Runner Assembly Diagram**). Add mottled black 1¹/₂×18¹/₂" inner border strips to remaining edges of table runner center. Press seams toward inner border. The table runner center now should be 18¹/₂×34¹/₂" including seam allowances.

Sew black floral 2¹/₂×34¹/₂" outer border strips to long edges of table runner center (**Table Runner Assembly Diagram**). Add black floral 2¹/₂×22¹/₂" outer border strips to remaining edges of table runner center. Press seams toward outer border to complete table runner top.

FINISH TABLE RUNNER

Layer table runner top, batting, and backing; baste. Quilt as desired.

2 Bind with orange floral binding strips.





Block C Diagram 4




Table Runner Assembly Diagram

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
