


# **PROJECT: Fall Favorites Quilt** Combine three beloved quilt blocks–Churn Dash, Courthouse Steps, and Irish Chain–in a seasonal quilt.

# FINISHED QUILT: 35<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" square FINISHED BLOCK: 16" square

#### MATERIALS

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

- □ 10" square *each* white print, cream print, and light brown print (blocks)
- <sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub> yard dark brown print (blocks, sashing)
- □ <sup>1</sup>/<sub>3</sub> yard gray print (sashing, borders)
- □ 3/8 yard solid black (binding)
- □ 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub> yards total assorted prints in brown, gray, orange, and white (blocks)
- 1¼ yards backing fabric
- □ 42" square batting

#### CUT FABRICS

Cut pieces in the following order.

If you prefer to make trianglesquares larger than necessary and trim them to size, cut 2" squares instead of the 17/8" squares specified here.

## From white print, cut:

- □ 4–1**%**" squares
- □ 12–1×2<sup>1</sup>/2" rectangles
- □ 4-1×1<sup>1</sup>/2" rectangles

## From cream print, cut:

- □ 4–1**%**" squares
- $\Box$  2–1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares
- □ 8–1×2<sup>1</sup>/2" rectangles
- From dark brown print, cut:
  - □ 4–1**1/8**" squares
  - □ 99–1<sup>1</sup>/2" squares
  - □ 8–1×2<sup>1</sup>/2" rectangles

## From light brown print, cut:

- □ 4-1<sup>7</sup>/8" squares
- □ 12–1×2<sup>1</sup>/2" rectangles
- $\Box$  4–l×l<sup>1</sup>/2" rectangles

## From gray print, cut:

- $\Box$  2–1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>×35<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" border strips
- $\Box$  2–1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>×33<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" border strips
- $\Box$  4–1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>×16<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" sashing rectangles

From solid black, cut:  $\Box 4-2^{1/2} \times 42^{"}$  binding strips

# ASSEMBLE CHURN DASH UNITS

Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Press seams in directions indicated by arrows on diagrams. If no direction is specified, press seam toward darker fabric.

**1** Use a pencil to mark a diagonal line on wrong side of each white print and cream print 17/8" square.

 $\begin{array}{l} 2 \quad \mbox{From white print gather two 17/8"} \\ \mbox{squares, six 1\times21/2" rectangles, and} \\ \mbox{two 1\times11/2" rectangles. From dark brown} \\ \mbox{print gather two 17/8" squares, four 1\times21/2"} \\ \mbox{rectangles, and one 11/2" square.} \end{array}$ 

Layer a marked white print square atop a dark brown print 1%" square. Sew together with two seams, stitching 1/4" on each side of marked line (Diagram 1). Cut apart on marked line. Press open to make two trianglesquares. Each triangle-square should be 11/2" square including seam allowances. Repeat to make four triangle-squares total.

A Referring to **Diagram 2**, sew together a white print 1×2<sup>1</sup>/2" rectangle and dark brown print 1×2<sup>1</sup>/2" rectangle to make a side unit. The unit should be 1<sup>1</sup>/2×2<sup>1</sup>/2" including seam allowances. Repeat to make four side units total.

**5** Referring to **Diagram 3**, sew white print  $1 \times 1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles to opposite edges of dark brown print  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Join white print  $1\times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles to remaining edges to make a center unit. The unit should be  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square including seam allowances.

**6** Referring to **Diagram 4**, lay out triangle-squares, side units, and

center unit in three rows. Sew together pieces in rows. Join rows to make a light Churn Dash unit. The unit should be  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square including seam allowances.

Repeat steps 2-6 to make a second light Churn Dash unit.

**8** From cream print gather two 1<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" squares, four cream print 1×2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" rectangles, and one 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" square. From light brown print gather two 1<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" squares, six 1×2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" rectangles, and two 1×1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" rectangles. Referring to **Diagram 5**, repeat steps 3-6 to make two dark Churn Dash units total.

## ASSEMBLE BLOCKS

**1** Referring to **Fabric Placement Diagram** and photo, *page 1*, select six assorted brown, gray, orange, and white prints in varying values; number them 1-6.

# **2** From Step 1 prints, cut:

- $\square$  8–1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>×4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" rectangles (print 1)
- $\square$  8-1<sup>1</sup>/2×6<sup>1</sup>/2" rectangles (print 2)
- $\square$  8-1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>×8<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" rectangles (print 3)
- $\square$  8-l<sup>1</sup>/2×10<sup>1</sup>/2" rectangles (print 4)
- $\square$  8–1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>×12<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" rectangles (print 5)
- $\square$  8-l<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>×l4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" rectangles (print 6)

**3** Referring to **Diagram 6**, sew print 1 rectangles to opposite edges of a light Churn Dash unit.

**4** Referring to **Diagram 7**, sew dark brown print 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares to ends of two print 1 rectangles to make pieced rows. Join pieced rows to top and bottom edges of Churn Dash unit. The unit now should be 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" square including seam allowances.

**5** Referring to **Diagram 8**, repeat steps 3 and 4 using print 2-6 rectangles in numerical order to make a light block. The block should be 16½" square including seam allowances.

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**6** Repeat steps 3-5 to make a second light block.

Z Repeat steps 1-5 using dark Churn Dash blocks to make two dark blocks.

#### ASSEMBLE QUILT TOP

2 Referring to Quilt Assembly Diagram, lay out blocks, gray print 1<sup>1</sup>/2×16<sup>1</sup>/2" sashing rectangles, and dark brown print 1<sup>1</sup>/2" sashing square in three rows. Sew together pieces in rows. Press seams toward sashing rectangles.

**2** Join rows to complete quilt center. Press seams in one direction. The quilt center should be 33<sup>1</sup>/2" square including seam allowances.

3 Sew gray print 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>×33<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" border strips to opposite edges of quilt center. Add gray print 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>×35<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" border strips to remaining edges to complete quilt top.

FINISH QUILT


 Layer quilt top, batting, and backing; baste. Quilt as desired.

Bind with solid black binding strips.









Diagram 5



Fabric Placement Diagram









