

PROJECT: Patriotic Spinner Table Runner

Decorate your summer table with a quick-to-sew runner.

FABRICS are from the Stonehenge Quilts of Valor collection by Northcott (*northcott.com*).



FINISHED TABLE RUNNER: 231/2×391/2 FINISHED BLOCK: 16" square

MATERIALS

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

- □ ²/₃ yard red star print (blocks)
- □ 1/3 yard mottled cream (blocks)
- □ 3/8 yard blue star print (blocks)
- 5/8 yard mottled blue (inner border, outer border, binding)
- □ 3/8 yard red, white, and blue stripe (outer border)
- □ 15/8 yards backing fabric
- □ 28×44" batting

CUT FABRICS

Cut pieces in the following order.

From red star print, cut:

- \Box 16-4\frac{1}{2}" squares
- \Box 64-2½" squares

From mottled cream, cut:

 \square 24–2½×4½" rectangles

From blue star print, cut:

 \square 8-4½×8½" rectangles

From mottled blue, cut:

- \Box 4-2½×42" binding strips
- \Box 4–3" squares
- \Box 2-1½×32½" inner border strips
- \Box 2–1½×18½" inner border strips

From red, white, and blue stripe, cut:

- \square 2-3×34 $\frac{1}{2}$ " outer border strips
- \Box 2-3×18½" outer border strips

ASSEMBLE BLOCKS

Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Press seams in directions indicated by arrows on diagrams. If no direction is specified, press seam toward darker fabric. **1** Use a pencil to mark a diagonal line on wrong side of 48 red star print 2½" squares and each red star print 4½" square.

2 Align a marked red star print 2½2 square with one end of a mottled cream 2½24½" rectangle (Diagram 1; note direction of marked line). Sew on marked line. Trim seam allowance to ½1". Press open attached triangle. Add a marked red star print 2½1" square to opposite end of rectangle to make a small Flying Geese unit. The unit still should be 2½24½1" including seam allowances. Repeat to make 24 small Flying Geese units total.

Jusing marked red star print 4½" squares and blue star print 4½×8½" rectangles, repeat Step 2 to make eight large Flying Geese units (Diagram 2). Each unit still should be 4½×8½" including seam allowances.

Lay out two remaining red star print 2½" squares and three small Flying Geese units in two rows (Diagram 3). Sew together pieces in rows. Join rows to make Unit A. The unit should be 4½×8½" including seam allowances. Repeat to make eight A units total.

5 Referring to **Diagram 4**, sew together one A unit and one large Flying Geese unit to make Unit B. The unit should be 8½" square including seam allowances. Repeat to make eight B units total.

Referring to **Diagram 5** for unit orientation, sew together four B units in pairs. Join pairs to make a block. The block should be 16½" square including seam allowances. Repeat to make a second block.

ASSEMBLE TABLE RUNNER

1 Referring to **Table Runner Assembly Diagram**, sew blocks together. Press seam in one direction to complete table runner center. The table runner center should be $16\frac{1}{2} \times 32\frac{1}{2}$ " including seam allowances.

2 Sew mottled blue 1½×32½" inner border strips to long edges of table runner center. Add mottled blue 1½×18½" inner border strips to remaining edges. Press seams towards inner border. The table runner center should be 18½×34½" including seam allowances.

3 Sew together two mottled blue 3" squares and one red, white, and blue 3×18½" strip to make a pieced outer border strip. The strip should be 3×23½" including seam allowances. Repeat to make a second pieced outer border strip.

Sew red. white, and blue 3×34½" outer border strips to long edges of table runner center. Add pieced outer border strips to remaining edges to complete table runner top.

FINISH TABLE RUNNER

1 Layer table runner top, batting, and backing; baste. Quilt as desired.

2 Bind with mottled blue binding strips.













Diagram 2

Unit B Diagram 4






Table Runner Assembly Diagram
