



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FINISHED BLOCK: 12" square**MATERIALS**

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

- 10" square *each* solid white, solid gray, solid aqua, solid coral, solid green, and solid yellow

CUT FABRICS

Cut pieces in the following order.

If you prefer to make triangle-squares larger than necessary and trim them to size, cut 4" squares instead of the 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares specified here.

From solid white, cut:

- 2-3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares

From solid gray, cut:

- 2-3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares

From solid aqua, cut:

- 3-4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares, cutting each diagonally twice in an X for a total of 12 small triangles

From solid coral, cut:

- 3-4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares, cutting each diagonally twice in an X for a total of 12 small triangles

From solid green, cut:

- 2-3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares, cutting each in half diagonally for a total of 4 large triangles

From solid yellow, cut:

- 4-3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares, cutting each in half diagonally for a total of 8 large triangles

ASSEMBLE BLOCK

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Press seams in directions indicated by arrows on diagrams. If no direction is specified, press seam toward darker fabric.

1 Use a pencil to mark a diagonal line on wrong side of each solid white 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " square.

2 Layer a marked solid white square atop a solid gray 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " square. Sew together with two seams, stitching $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of drawn line (**Diagram 1**). Cut pair apart on drawn line to make two triangles. Press triangles open to make two triangle-squares. Each triangle-square should be 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square including seam allowances. Repeat to make four triangle-squares total.

3 Referring to **Diagram 2** for color placement, sew together an aqua small triangle and a coral small triangle. Add a green large triangle to make Unit A. The unit should be 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square including seam allowances. Repeat to make four A units total.

4 Referring to **Diagram 3** for color placement, repeat Step 3 using yellow large triangles to make four B units total.

5 Referring to **Diagram 4** for color placement, repeat Step 4 to make four C units total.

6 Referring to **Diagram 5**, lay out triangle-squares and A, B, and C units in four rows. Sew together pieces in rows, pressing seams in opposite directions.

7 Join rows to complete block. Press seams in one direction. The block should be 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square including seam allowances.

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










