

PROJECT: Nine-Patch Block

FINISHED BLOCK: 6" square

MATERIALS

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

- Scraps of solid teal and solid white

CUT FABRICS

Cut pieces in the following order.

From solid teal, cut:

- 5-2½" squares

From solid white, cut:

- 4-2½" squares

ASSEMBLE BLOCK

Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Press seams in directions indicated by arrows on diagrams. If no direction is specified, press seam toward darker fabric.

1. Referring to **Diagram 1**, lay out five solid teal 2½" squares and four solid white 2½" squares in three rows. Sew together pieces in each row. Join rows to make a Nine-Patch block. The block should be 6½" square including seam allowances.

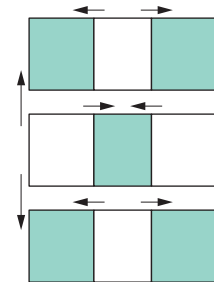
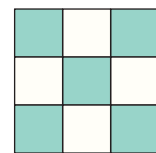


DIAGRAM 1
