

PROJECT: Square Knot



Quilters often give their time and talents to make quilts for charity. The instructions include yardage and cutting lists for four popular charity sizes (in addition to the original quilt size).

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

Measurements include 1/4" seam allowances.
Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Press seams in directions indicated by arrows on diagrams. If no direction is specified, press seam toward darker fabric.

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CUT FABRICS

Choose your quilt size on the chart on page 3. Referring to the chart, cut needed materials.

ASSEMBLE BLOCKS

- 1. For one block, gather two $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and two $2\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles from one assorted print, one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square from a contrasting print, two solid white $1\times 6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, and two solid white $1\times 7\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.
- **2.** Referring to **Diagram 1,** sew matching print $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares to opposite edges of contrasting print $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Join matching print $2\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles to remaining edges to make block center. The block center should be $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square including seam allowances.
- **3.** Sew solid white 1×6½" rectangles to opposite edges of block center (**Diagram 2**). Add solid white 1×7½" rectangles to remaining edges to make a block. The block should be 7½" square including seam allowances.
- **4.** Repeat steps 1–3 to make number of blocks indicated on *page 3* for quilt size chosen.

ASSEMBLE QUILT TOP

1. Referring to Quilt Assembly
Diagram, lay out solid white 2" sashing squares, solid dark gray 2×7½" sashing rectangles, and blocks in number of horizontal rows indicated in chart on page 3. Sew together pieces in each row. Press seams toward sashing rectangles. Join rows to make quilt center. Press seams away from block rows. See chart, page 3, for quilt center size, including seam allowances.

2. Cut and piece (if necessary) solid dark gray 2×42" strips to make border strips in lengths indicated in chart, page 3. Sew long border strips to long edges of quilt center. Add short border strips to remaining edges to complete quilt top. Press all seams toward border.

FINISH QUILT

- 1. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing; baste
- **2.** Quilt as desired. Designer Jo Kramer machine-quilted echoing swirl patterns across the quilt top (Quilting Diagram).
- 3. Bind with solid black binding strips.







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









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QUILT ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM
