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Silly pumpkin pincushions are sure to elicit smiles from any sewer. Use them as decorations or give away as sweet Halloween treats!

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#### Project: Silly Pumpkin Pincushions

## Materials

- Freezer paper
- Felt: moss green, dark orange, orange, and scraps of red, ivory, and gold
- #8 pearl cotton: white, black, and green
- Polyester fiberfill
- Embellishments for stems: cloth tape measure, golf tee, and artificial flowers
- Crafts glue
- Cardstock
- Buttons in various sizes for eyes
- Embellishments for noses, such as a checker, bingo marker, or die

## **Cut Fabrics**

From moss green felt, cut: • 1-6×10" rectangle From dark orange felt, cut: • 2-7×8" rectangles From orange felt, cut: • 1-6×10" rectangle

## Assemble Pincushions

- Position the freezer paper, shiny side down, over the patterns (pages 3-4). Trace the patterns the number of times indicated. Cut out the shapes on the traced lines.
- 2. Using an iron, press a freezerpaper shape, shiny side down, onto the front of the respective fabric (use the picture as a guide); let cool. Cut out the shape along the pattern edges. Peel off the freezer paper.
- Backstitch a line in the center of each mouth with #8 pearl cotton. Work straight stitches at intervals along the mouth lines.
- **4.** Backstitch a circle on the dark orange pumpkin's eye patch.


- With right sides together and using a ¼-inch seam allowance, sew the fronts of the pumpkins to the backs, leaving an opening at the top of each pumpkin for turning; turn right side out.
- Stuff with fiberfill. Hand-sew the openings closed, leaving <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>-inch openings to insert the stems.

## **Finish Pincushions**

- For the tape-measure stem, cut two 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"lengths from the tape measure. Glue a <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>×2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strip of cardstock between the two lengths. Glue in place.
- 2. For the artificial-flower stem, tie a small bunch of flowers and leaves with a length of pearl cotton. Glue in place.
- **3.** Sew buttons in place for eyes. Glue the noses in place.


