Attach a bow-wrapped card to your presents for an handmade touch this holiday. The gift jumps off the card with the help of 3-D foam.

## Project: Wrapped Present Card

**Materials**

- 5½×4" rectangle olive green cardstock
- 6×9" rectangle purple cardstock
- 2—4" square white cardstock
- 5½×4" rectangle gold print
- 3½" square of red print
- 3½" square of green print
- Lightweight fusible web
- Pinking shears
- 3-D foam tape

Finished card: 6×4½"

**Use Fusible**

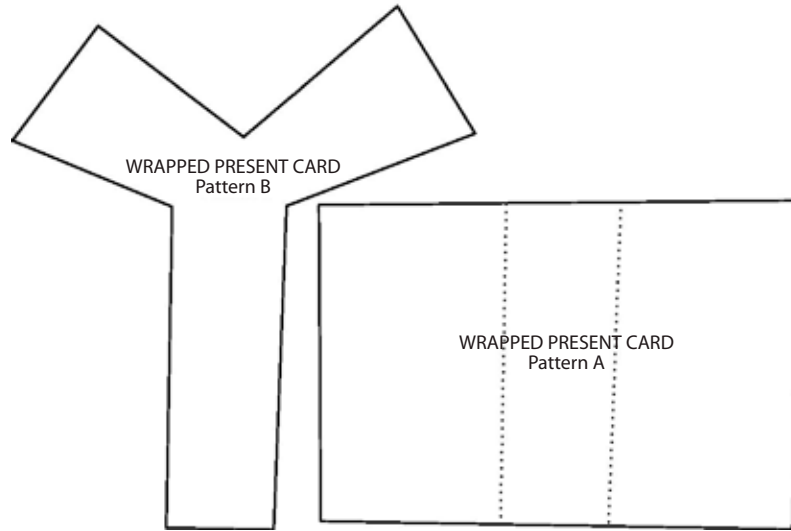
To use iron-on fusible web for appliquéing, complete the following steps.

1. Lay fusible web, paper side up, over patterns. Use a pencil to trace each pattern the number of times indicated in cutting instructions, leaving ½" between tracings. Cut out each fusible-web shape roughly ¼" outside traced lines.
2. Following manufacturer's instructions, press fusible-web shapes onto wrong sides of designated fabrics; let cool. Cut out fabric shapes on drawn lines. Peel off paper backings.

**Assemble Card**

1. Apply fusible web to a gold print 5½×4" rectangle; let cool. Using pinking shears, trim rectangle to 4¾×3¼". Remove paper backing; center and fuse onto an olive green cardstock 5½×4" rectangle.
2. Fold a purple cardstock 6×9" rectangle in half to make a 6×4½" card. Center and glue olive green rectangle to card front.
3. Apply fusible web to red print and lime green print 3½" squares. Fuse each fabric square to a white cardstock 4" square. From the red fused cardstock square, trace and cut a Pattern A present. From the lime green fused cardstock square, trace and cut a Pattern B bow. Patterns are on page 3.
4. Use scraps of fusible web to adhere bow to present. Use 3-D foam tape to adhere present to card front.

**\* NOTE:**  
When printing a downloadable pdf, set Page Scaling preference to NONE to print patterns at 100%. Do NOT "Shrink to Fit" or "Fit to Printable Area."
