# Stitches to Savor: Scroll Stitch

### Materials

- Perle cotton No. 3
- Chenille needle No. 18

## Scroll Stitch

- Thread 18" length of perle cotton on a No. 18 chenille needle and sew a row of scroll stitches around circle appliqué edge. To begin, pull needle up at A alongside the appliqué edge (Diagram 1). Insert needle tip into the fabric at B (about ¼" away from A) and bring it up again at C, picking up small amount of background and appliqué fabrics, to make a tiny stitch perpendicular to appliqué edge. Do not pull needle through.
- 2. Working counterclockwise, pass the thread under needle eye, then under the needle tip (Diagram 2).
- 3. Tighten thread around needle shaft (Diagram 3), then pull needle through to complete a scroll stitch (Diagram 4).
- Repeat to make next stitch about ¼" away from first stitch (Diagram 5). Continue in same manner to make scroll stitches around entire appliqué edge.


