## Materials

- Yellow print and blue print scraps

Finished block: 81/2" square

Cut the Fabrics
From yellow print, cut:

- $3-33 / 8$ " squares, cutting each diagonally twice in an $X$ for a total of 12 large triangles
- 2-2" squares, cutting each in half diagonally for a total of 4 small triangles
- $1-2 \times 5$ " rectangle
- $2-2$ " squares

From blue print, cut:

- $2-2 \times 5$ " rectangles
- $6-2 \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
- 2-2" squares
