

Project: Roman Square

Materials

- White print, light pink print, and dark pink print scraps

Finished block: 9" square

Cut the Fabrics

From white print, cut:

- 3—1½×12" strips

From light pink print, cut:

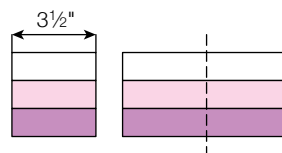
- 3—1½×12" strips

From dark pink print, cut:

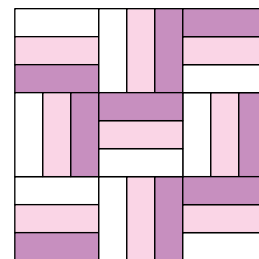
- 3—1½×12" strips

Assemble the Block

1. Aligning long edges, sew together one white print strip, one light pink print strip, and one dark pink print strip to make a strip set (**Strip Set Diagram**). Repeat to make a total of three strip sets.
2. Cut each strip set into three 3½" segments for a total of nine.
3. Lay out the segments in three horizontal rows (**Block Assembly Diagram**). Sew together the pieces in each row. Press the seam allowances toward the segments that are running up and down. Then join the rows to make a block. Press the seam allowances in one direction.
