

## Project: Sawtooth Star

### Materials

- Gold floral and cream print scraps

**Finished block:** 8" square

### Cut the Fabrics

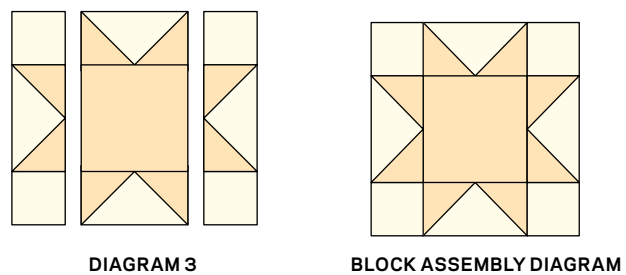
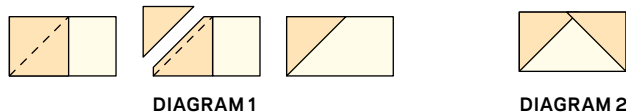
#### From gold floral, cut:

- 1—4½" square
- 8—2½" squares

#### From cream print, cut:

- 4—2½"×4½" rectangles
- 4—2½" squares

units to the remaining edges of the gold floral 4½" square to make a block (**Block Assembly Diagram**). Press the seam allowances toward the gold floral square.



### Assemble the Block

1. For accurate sewing lines, use a quilting pencil to mark each gold floral 2½" square with a diagonal line on the wrong side of the fabric.
2. Align one marked gold floral 2½" square with one end of a cream print 2½"×4½" rectangle (**Diagram 1; note the placement of the sewing line**). Stitch on the marked line; trim the seam allowance to ¼". Press open the attached gold floral triangle. Repeat the sewing with a second marked gold floral 2½" square on the opposite end of the rectangle to make a Flying Geese unit (**Diagram 2**). Repeat to make a total of four Flying Geese units.
3. Sew a Flying Geese unit to opposite edges of the gold floral 4½" square (**Diagram 3**). Press the seam allowances toward the gold floral square.
4. Add a cream print 2½" square to each end of the remaining Flying Geese units. Press the seam allowances toward the cream print squares. Join these
