

Project: Sawtooth Star

Materials

Gold floral and cream print scraps

Finished block: 8" square

units to the remaining edges of the gold floral 4½" square to make a block (Block Assembly Diagram). Press the seam allowances toward the gold floral square.

Cut the Fabrics

From gold floral, cut:

- 1-4½" square
- 8-2**½**" squares

From cream print, cut:

- 4-21/2×41/2" rectangles
- 4-2**½**" squares

Assemble the Block

- 1. For accurate sewing lines, use a quilting pencil to mark each gold floral 21/2" square with a diagonal line on the wrong side of the fabric.
- 2. Align one marked gold floral 21/2" square with one end of a cream print 21/2×41/2" rectangle (Diagram 1; note the placement of the sewing line). Stitch on the marked line; trim the seam allowance to 1/4". Press open the attached gold floral triangle. Repeat the sewing with a second marked gold floral 21/2" square on the opposite end of the rectangle to make a Flying Geese unit (Diagram 2). Repeat to make a total of four Flying Geese units.
- 3. Sew a Flying Geese unit to opposite edges of the gold floral 4½" square (Diagram 3). Press the seam allowances toward the gold floral square.
- 4. Add a cream print 2½" square to each end of the remaining Flying Geese units. Press the seam allowances toward the cream print squares. Join these




DIAGRAM 3
