

Project: Double Nine-Patch

Materials

- White print and green print scraps

Finished block: 9" square

Cut the Fabrics

From white print, cut:

- 4— $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- 20— $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

From green print, cut:

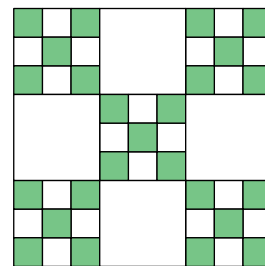
- 25— $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

Assemble the Block

1. Lay out four white print $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and five green print $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares in three horizontal rows (**Diagram 1**). Sew together the squares in each row. Press the seam allowances toward the green print squares. Then join the rows to make a Nine-Patch unit. The pieced Nine-Patch unit should measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square, including the seam allowances. Repeat to make a total of five Nine-Patch units.
2. Lay out the Nine-Patch units and white print $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares in three horizontal rows (**Block Assembly Diagram**). Sew together the squares in each row. Press the seam allowances toward the white print squares. Then join the rows to make a block. Press the seam allowances in one direction.
