# **Project: Flying Geese**

# Materials

Tan print and green print scraps

Finished block: 8" square

## Cut the Fabrics

#### From tan print, cut:


 2—4<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" squares, cutting each in half diagonally for a total of 4 triangles


#### From green print, cut:

 2—4% squares, cutting each in half diagonally for a total of 4 triangles

### Assemble the Block

- Sew together one tan print triangle and one green print triangle to make a triangle square (Triangle-Square Diagram). Press the seam allowance toward the green triangle. Repeat to make a total of four triangle-squares.
- Sew together the triangle squares in pairs. Press the seam allowances in opposite directions. Then join the pairs to make a block (Block Assembly Diagram). Press the seam allowance in one direction.
