

Project: Flying Geese

Materials

- Tan print and green print scraps

Finished block: 8" square

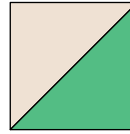
Cut the Fabrics

From tan print, cut:

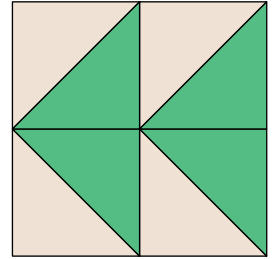
- 2— $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares, cutting each in half diagonally for a total of 4 triangles

From green print, cut:

- 2— $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares, cutting each in half diagonally for a total of 4 triangles

BLOCK ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM

Assemble the Block

1. Sew together one tan print triangle and one green print triangle to make a triangle square (**Triangle-Square Diagram**). Press the seam allowance toward the green triangle. Repeat to make a total of four triangle-squares.
2. Sew together the triangle squares in pairs. Press the seam allowances in opposite directions. Then join the pairs to make a block (**Block Assembly Diagram**). Press the seam allowance in one direction.
