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Project: Funky Fusible Flowers

INSPIRED BY IMAGINE THAT FROM DESIGNER TONYE BELINDA PHILLIPS (TONYEBELINDAPHILLIPS.COM)





Use fusible appliqué and a small zigzag stitch to assemble a wall hanging using the April Showers Bring Sunflowers collection by Art of Possibility Studios for FreeSpirit (freespiritfabric.com).

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Materials

- 5/8 yard gray print (bowl appliqué, stamen appliqués)
- 1 yard blue-and-yellow print (appliqué foundation)
- ¾ yard green print (stem appliqués, tendril appliqués, inner border)
- 1½ yards multicolor print (stamen appliqués, outer border, binding)
- 5×10" rectangle of circle print (flower appliqués)
- 6" square orange dot (flower appliqué)
- 1/8 yard purple dot (inner border)
- ¼ yard each of orange print
 No. 1 and orange print No. 2
 (flower appliqués, inner border)
- 7" square yellow-and-red floral (flower appliqué)
- 1/4 yard blue tone-on-tone (inner border)
- 1/8 yard yellow-and-blue floral (inner border)
- 3½ yards backing fabric
- 55×62" batting
- Lightweight fusible web

Finished quilt: 461/2×531/2"

Quantities are for 44/45"-wide, 100% cotton fabrics.

Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Cut Fabrics

Cut pieces in the following order. Patterns are on pages 5 and 6. To use fusible web for appliqués, complete the following steps.

Cut a 5x15" rectangle of fusible web. Press fusible-web rectangle onto wrong side of green print. Cut fused rectangle into 4—½x14" stem appliqué strips and 2—½x10" stem appliqué strips.

- 2. Cut a 7" square of fusible web. Press fusible-web square onto wrong side of multicolor print. Cut fused rectangle into 1—1/4x5" stamen appliqué, 2—1/4x41/2" stamen appliqués, 12—1/4x31/2" stamen appliqués, and 7—1/4x21/2" stamen appliqués.
- 3. Lay additional fusible web, paper side up, over patterns. Use a pencil to trace each pattern the number of times indicated in cutting instructions, leaving ½" between tracings. Cut out each fusible-web shape roughly ¼" outside traced lines
- 4. Following manufacturer's instructions, press fusible-web shapes onto wrong sides of designated fabrics; let cool. Cut out fabric shapes on drawn lines. Peel off paper backings.

From gray print, cut:

- 1 of Pattern A
- 22 of Pattern J

From blue-and-yellow print, cut:

■ 1—30½×38½" foundation rectangle

From green print, cut:

- 5 of Pattern B
- 4 of Pattern B reversed
- 9-2**1/8**" squares

From multicolor print, cut:

- 5—5**½**×42" strips for outer border
- 6-2**½**×42" binding strips
- 9 of Pattern C

From circle print, cut:

- 1 of Pattern D
- 1 of Pattern H

From orange dot, cut:

1 of Pattern E

From orange print No. 1, cut:

- 1 of Pattern F
- 19-2**1/8**" squares

From purple dot, cut:

2—1½×36½" inner border strips

From orange print No. 2, cut:

- 1—1**½**×30" strip
- 1 of Pattern G

From yellow-and-red floral, cut:

1 of Pattern I

From blue tone-on-tone, cut:

- 1—1½×30" strip
- 28-2**%**" squares

From yellow-and-blue floral, cut:

2—1½×38½" inner border strips

Appliqué Quilt Center

- 1. Referring to Quilt Assembly
 Diagram, place gray print A vase
 appliqué on blue-and-yellow
 print 30½×38½" foundation
 rectangle. Tuck an end of each
 green stem appliqué under
 top edge of vase. To help
 decide placement and length
 of stems, arrange appliqué
 pieces B-J and multicolor
 print stamen appliqués on
 foundation, adjusting stamen
 lengths as desired. Following
 manufacturer's instructions,
 fuse pieces in place.
- Working from bottom layer to the top, use coordinating thread and a small zigzag stitch to machine-appliqué pieces in place.

Assemble and Add Inner Border Units

1. Use a pencil to mark a diagonal line on wrong side of each blue tone-on-tone 21/8" square.

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- 2. Layer a marked blue tone-ontone square atop an orange print No. 1-27/8" square. Sew together with two seams, stitching 1/4" on each side of drawn line (Diagram 1). Cut apart on drawn line to make two triangle units. Press each triangle unit open, pressing seam away from blue tone-ontone, to make two blue-andorange triangle-squares. Each should be 21/2" square including seam allowances. Repeat to make 38 blue-and-orange triangle-squares total.
- 3. Using green print 2%" squares instead of orange print No. 1 squares, repeat Step 2 to make 18 blue-and-green triangle-squares total (Diagram 2).
- 4. Sew together 19 blue-andorange triangle-squares in a row (Quilt Assembly Diagram, note direction of seams). Press seams in one direction. Join triangle-square row to a yellowand-blue floral 11/2×381/2" strip to make a side inner border unit. Press seam toward yellow-andblue floral strip. The unit should be 3½×38½" including seam allowances. Repeat to make a second side inner border unit. Sew side inner border units to side edges of quilt center. Press seams toward border units.

- 5. Referring to Quilt Assembly
 Diagram, join 18 blue-and-green
 triangle-squares in a row; press
 seams in one direction. Add
 triangle-square row to purple dot
 1⅓2×36⅓2" strip to make bottom
 inner border unit. Press seam
 toward purple dot strip. The unit
 should be 3⅓2×36⅓2" including
 seam allowances. Add bottom
 inner border unit to bottom
 edge of quilt center. Press seam
 toward border unit.
- 6. Sew together blue tone-ontone 1½×30" strip and orange print No. 2—1½×30" strip to make a strip set (Diagram 3). Press seam toward orange print No. 2. Cut strip set into 18—1½"-wide segments. Join segments along short edges to make a checkerboard row (Quilt Assembly Diagram). Press seams toward orange print No. 2. The checkerboard row should be 1½×36½" including seam allowances.
- 7. Sew together checkerboard row and purple dot 1½×36½" strip to make top inner border unit. Press seam toward purple dot. The unit should be 2½×36½" including seam allowances. Add to top edge of quilt center. Press seam toward border unit.

Add Outer Border


- 1. Cut and piece multicolor print 5½×42" strips to make:
 - 2—5½×46½" outer border strips
 - 2-5½×43½" outer border strips
- 2. Sew short outer border strips to side edges of quilt center. Add long outer border strips to top and bottom edges to complete quilt top. Press all seams toward outer border.

Finish Quilt


- **1.** Layer quilt top, batting, and backing; baste. Quilt as desired.
- **2.** Bind with multicolor print binding strips.
