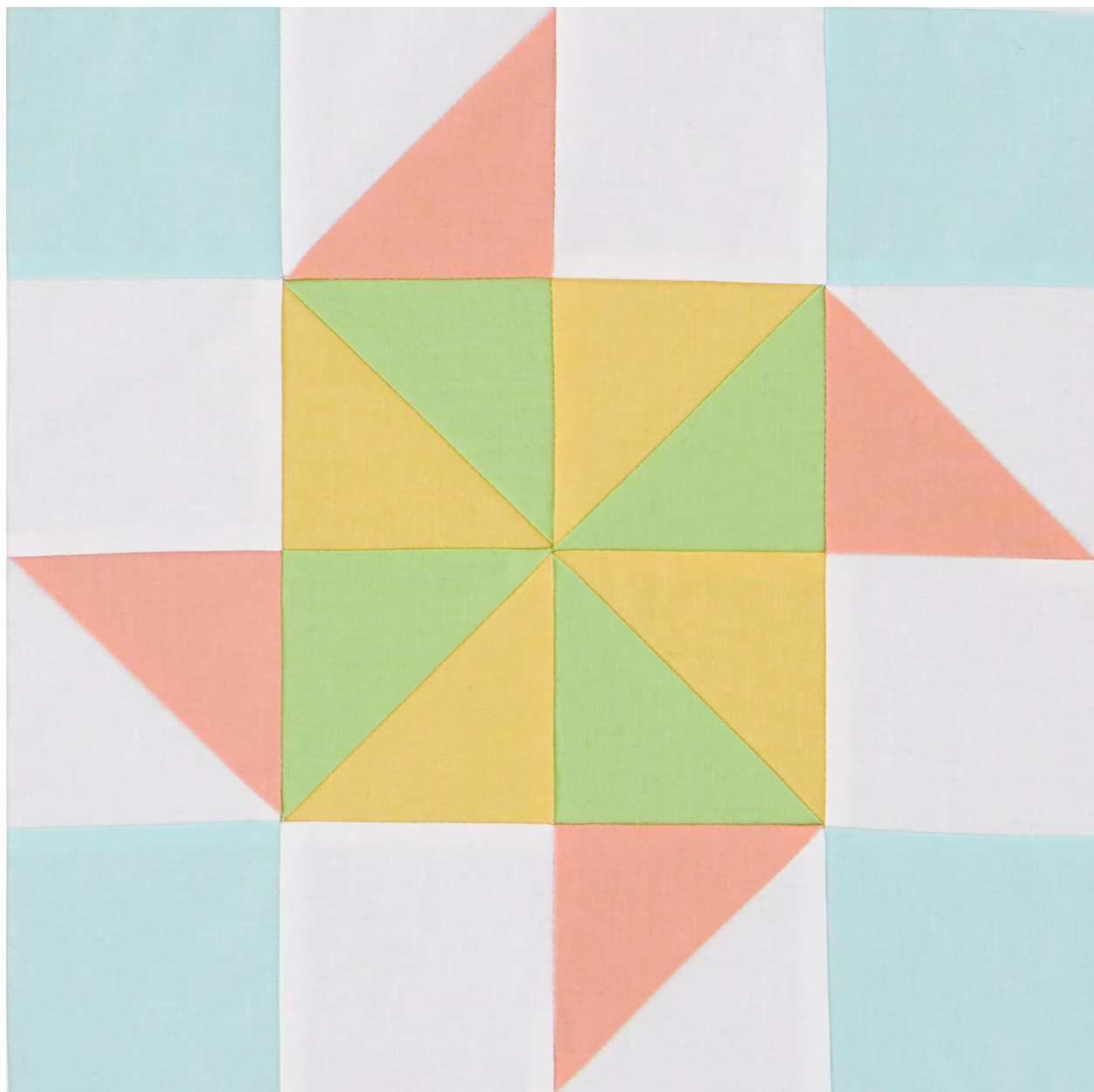


PROJECT: Bright New Day Block 12
American Patchwork & Quilting
2021 Block of the Month

FABRICS are from the Bella Solids collection by Moda Fabrics (*modafabrics.com*).

FINISHED BLOCK: 12" square**MATERIALS**

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

- 9x21" piece (fat eighth) solid white
- 10" square *each* solid yellow, solid coral, solid green, and solid aqua

CUT FABRICS

Cut pieces in the following order.

If you prefer to make triangle-squares larger than necessary and trim them to size, cut 4" squares instead of the $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares specified here.

From solid white, cut:

- 2- $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares
- 4- $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

From solid yellow, cut:

- 2- $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares

From solid coral, cut:

- 2- $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares

From solid green, cut:

- 2- $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares


From solid aqua, cut:

- 4- $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

ASSEMBLE BLOCK

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Press seams in directions indicated by arrows on diagrams. If no direction is specified, press seam toward darker fabric.

1 Use a pencil to mark a diagonal line  on wrong side of each solid white $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square and each solid yellow $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square.

2 Layer a marked solid white $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square atop a solid coral $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square. Sew together with two seams, stitching $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of drawn line (**Diagram 1**). Cut apart on drawn line. Press open to make two triangle-squares. Each triangle-square should be $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square including seam allowances. Repeat to make four coral triangle-squares total.

3 Repeat Step 2 using marked solid yellow $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares and solid green $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares to make four green triangle-squares (**Diagram 2**).

4 Referring to **Diagram 3**, sew together a coral triangle-square and solid white $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square to make a side unit. The side unit should be $3\frac{1}{2}$ x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " including seam allowances. Repeat to make four side units total.

5 Referring to **Diagram 4**, sew together green triangle-squares in pairs. Join pairs to complete a center unit. The center unit should be $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square including seam allowances.

6 Referring to **Diagram 5**, lay out solid aqua $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, side units, and center unit in three rows. Sew together pieces in rows. Join rows to complete block. The block should be $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square including seam allowances.

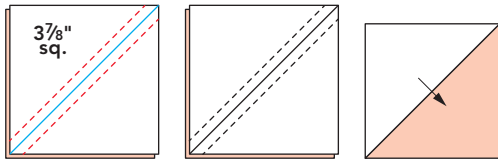

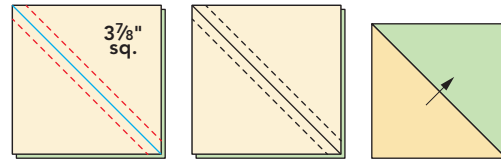

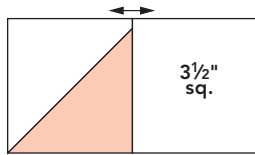

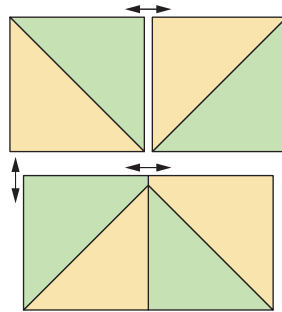

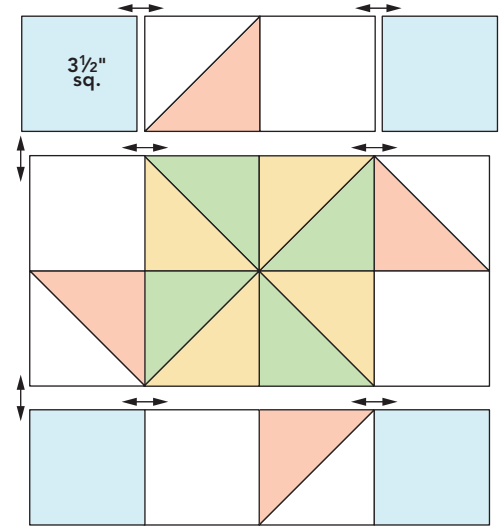
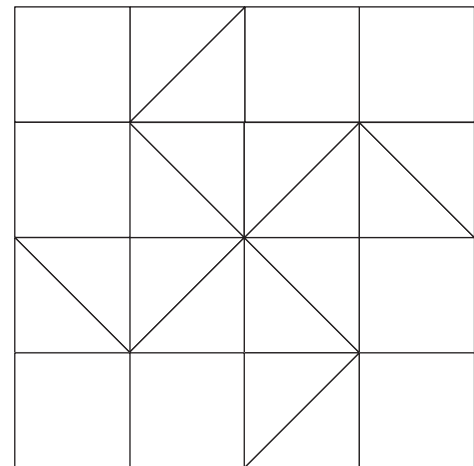
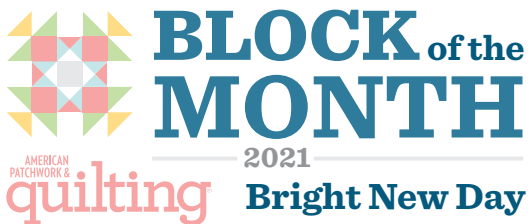
