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Project: Easy Steps

The key to achieving the stair-step look is cutting the 2½"-wide strips different lengths. The black-and-white prints allow the red squares to pop off the wall hanging.

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Materials

- ¾ yard red floral (quilt center, binding)
- 2/3 yard white floral (quilt center)
- 1 yard total assorted black prints (quilt center)
- ½ yard solid black (border)
- 2**1/8** yards backing fabric
- 51×53" batting

Finished quilt: 421/2×441/2"

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Cut Fabrics

Cut pieces in the following order.

From red floral, cut:

- $5-2\frac{1}{2}\times42$ " binding strips
- 64-21/2" squares

From white floral, cut:

- 25-21/2×101/2" strips
- 3-21/2×81/2" strips
- 3-2½×6½" strips
- $-3-2\frac{1}{2}\times4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips
- 4-2**½**" squares

From assorted black prints, cut:

- 26-21/2×101/2" strips
- 3-21/2×81/2" strips
- 3-2½×6½" strips
- 3-2**½**×4**½**" strips
- 3—2**½**" squares

From solid black, cut:

■ 5—2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ×42" strips for border

Assemble Quilt Top

- Referring to Quilt Assembly
 Diagram, lay out red floral
 squares, white floral strips and
 squares, and assorted black
 print strips and squares in 20
 horizontal rows.
- 2. Sew together pieces in each row. Press seams toward red floral squares. Join rows to complete quilt top; press seams in one direction.
- 3. Cut and piece solid black 2½×42" strips to make:
 - 2-21/2×441/2" border strips
 - 2—2½×38½" border strips
- 4. Sew short border strips to short ends of quilt center. Add long border strips to remaining edges to complete quilt top. Press all seams toward border.

Finish Ouilt

- **1.** Layer quilt top, batting, and backing; baste. Quilt as desired.
- 2. Bind with red floral binding strips.



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
