
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# Project: Out of the Blue

INSPIRED BY LAYER UPON LAYER FROM DESIGNER MONIQUE DILLARD OF OPEN GATE QUILTS (OPENGATEQUILTS.COM) QUILT TESTER: LAURA BOEHNKE





A range of blues from light to medium to dark forms a grid look in this wall hanging. Dark floral squares emerge from assorted lighter blues to give the project depth.



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Project: Out of the Blue

- Materials
- 5% yard blue geometric print (blocks)
- 4—1/8-yard pieces assorted blue prints (blocks)
- <sup>1</sup>√3 yard blue large floral (blocks)
- ¾ yard blue small floral (blocks, outer border)
- % yard blue scallop print (blocks, outer border)
- 2/3 yard dark blue tone-on-tone (blocks, inner border, binding)
- 5/8 yard light blue floral (blocks, outer border)
- 1¼ yards backing fabric
- 42" square batting

Finished quilt: 33½" square Finished block: 12" square

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

## **Cut Fabrics**

Cut pieces in the following order.

From blue geometric print, cut:

- 4—3**½**×21" strips
- 8—2×10" strips
- 32—2" squares
- From *each* assorted blue print, cut:
- 1—2×21" strip
- 1—2×10" strip
- From blue large floral, cut:
- 32—3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares
- From blue small floral, cut:
- 16—2×5" rectangles
- 36—2" squares
- From blue scallop print, cut:
- 16—2×5" rectangles
- 36—2" squares
- From dark blue tone-on-tone, cut:
- 4—2**½**×42" binding strips
- 2—2×27<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" inner border strips
- 2—2×24½" inner border strips
- 16—2" squares

From light blue floral, cut:44-3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares

## Assemble Corner Units

- Sew together a blue geometric print 3½×21" strip and a blue print 2×21" strip to make Strip Set A (Diagram 1). Press seam toward blue print. Repeat to make four total of Strip Set A. Cut strip sets into forty 2"-wide A segments. (You will end up using 32 A segments.)
- Join two blue geometric print 2×10" strips and one blue print 2×10" strip to make Strip Set B (Diagram 2). Press seams toward blue print. Repeat to make four total of Strip Set B. Cut strip sets into twenty 2"wide B segments. (You will end up using 16 B segments).
- 3. Referring to Diagram 3, sew together two A segments and one B segment to make a chain unit. Press seam in one direction. The chain unit should be 5" square including seam allowances. Repeat to make 16 chain units total.
- Use a pencil or chalk marker to draw a diagonal line on wrong side of each blue large floral 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" square.
- Align a marked blue large floral square with one corner of a chain unit (Diagram 4; note direction of drawn line). Stitch on drawn line. Trim excess, leaving a ¼" seam allowance. Press open attached triangle, pressing seam toward blue large floral.
- In same manner, add a second marked blue large floral square to opposite corner of Step 5 chain unit to make a corner unit (Diagram 5).

7. Repeat steps 5 and 6 to make 16 corner units total.

### Assemble Blocks

- Use a pencil to draw a diagonal line on wrong side of each blue geometric print 2" square.
- Align a marked blue geometric print square with one end of a blue small floral 2×5" rectangle (Diagram 6; note direction of drawn line). Stitch on drawn line, then trim, leaving ¼" seam allowance. Press open attached triangle, pressing seam toward blue small floral, to make a left point unit. Repeat to make 16 left point units total.
- Using blue scallop print instead of blue small floral, repeat Step 2 to make 16 right point units (Diagram 7; note direction of drawn line).
- Join left and right point units to make a side unit (Diagram 8). Press seam toward left point unit. The unit should be 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>×5" including seam allowances. Repeat to make 16 side units total.
- 5. Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of each dark blue tone-on-tone 2" square.
- Align a marked dark blue toneon-tone square with one corner of a light blue floral 3½" square. Stitch on drawn line then trim, leaving ¼" seam allowance (Diagram 9). Press open attached triangle, pressing seam toward light blue floral. In same manner, add a second marked dark blue tone-on-tone square to opposite corner of light blue floral square. Add marked dark blue tone-on-tone squares to remaining corners, pressing

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seams toward dark blue tone-ontone instead, to make a Squarein-a-Square unit. Repeat to make four Square-in-a-Square units total.

 Referring to Diagram 10, lay out four corner units, four side units, and one Square-in-a-Square unit in three rows. Sew together pieces in each row. Press seams toward side units. Join rows to make a block. Press seams away from middle row. The block should be 12<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" square including seam allowances. Repeat to make four blocks total.

### Assemble Quilt Center

- Referring to Quilt Assembly Diagram, lay out blocks in two pairs, rotating alternating blocks so seams abut.
- 2. Sew together blocks in pairs. Press seams in one direction, alternating direction with each pair.
- Join pairs to make quilt center. Press seams in one direction. The quilt center should be 24<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" square including seam allowances.

### Assemble and Add Borders

- Sew dark blue tone-on-tone 2×24<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" inner border strips to opposite edges of quilt center. Add dark blue tone-on-tone 2×27<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" inner border strips to remaining edges. Press all seams toward inner border.
- Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of each blue scallop print and blue small floral 2" square.

- Align a marked blue scallop print square with one corner of a light blue floral 3½" square. Stitch, trim, and press attached triangle toward light blue floral. In same manner, add a marked blue small floral square to adjacent corner of light blue floral square, pressing seam toward blue small floral instead, to make a border unit (Diagram 11). Repeat to make 36 border units total.
- Referring to Quilt Assembly Diagram, sew together nine border units to make a short outer border strip. Press seams in one direction. The strip should be 3½×27½" including seam allowances. Repeat to make a second short outer border strip.
- Referring to Quilt Assembly Diagram, join two light blue floral 3½" squares and nine border units to make a long outer border strip. Press seams in one direction. The strip should be 3½x33½" including seam allowances. Repeat to make a second long outer border strip.
- 6. Sew short outer border strips to opposite edges of quilt center. Add long outer border strips to remaining edges to complete quilt top. Press all seams toward inner border.


### Finish Quilt

- **1.** Layer quilt top, batting and backing, baste. Quilt as desired.
- **2.** Bind with dark blue tone-on-tone binding strips.

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






DIAGRAM 3








