Project: Scrappy Pincushion

Bright fabric scraps make up a merry Log Cabin pincushion.

Materials

- Scraps of light and medium prints (block, backing)
- Polyester fiberfill
- 2—1"-diameter buttons

Finished pincushion: 4" square

Measurements include 1/4" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Cut Fabrics

Cut pieces in the following order.

From assorted medium prints, cut:

- 1-4½" square
- 1—1×4½" rectangle for position 12
- 1—1×4" rectangle for position 11
- $1-1\times3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle for position 8
- $1-1\times3$ " rectangle for position 7
- $1-1\times2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle for position 4
- 1—1×2" rectangle for position 3
- 1—1½" square

From assorted light prints, cut:

- 1—1×4" rectangle for position 10
- $1-1\times3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle for position 9
- 1—1×3" rectangle for position 6
- $1-1\times2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle for position 5
- 1—1×2" rectangle for position 2
- $1-1\times1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle for position 1

Assemble Pincushion

- 1. Sew together a position 1 rectangle and medium print 1½" square to make block center (Diagram 1). Press seam allowance toward rectangle.
- 2. Add a position 2 rectangle to left-hand edge of block center (Diagram 2). Press seam allowance away from block center.
- 3. Add a position 3 rectangle to top edge of block center; press as before (Diagram 3).
- 4. Referring to Diagram 4, continue sewing rectangles to block center in a clockwise direction to make Log Cabin block. Press all seams away from block center. The block should be 41/2" square including seam allowances.
- 5. Layer Log Cabin block and a 41/2" square right sides together; stitch around all edges, leaving a 2" opening along one edge for turning. Turn pincushion to right side. Stuff with fiberfill. Slipstitch opening closed.
- 6. Center one button on pincushion top and a second one on the bottom. Taking long stitches through the center of pincushion, sew buttons firmly in place.


