

Project: Easy Squares Table Topper

Materials

- % yard total assorted green prints (setting squares, border)
- ½ yard total assorted plum prints (blocks, border)
- ½ yard total assorted pink prints (blocks, border)
- % yard plum print (binding)
- 11/8 yards backing fabric
- 39" square batting

Finished quilt: 32½" square Finished block: 8" square

Quantities are for 44/45"-wide, 100% cotton fabrics.

Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Cut Fabrics

Cut pieces in the following order.

From assorted green prints, cut:

- 4—8½" setting squares
- $8-4\frac{1}{2}\times8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

From assorted plum prints, cut:

■ 18-4½" squares

From assorted pink prints, cut:

■ 14-4½" squares

From plum print, cut:

■ 4-21/2×42" binding strips

Assemble Four-Patch Blocks

Sew together two plum print and two pink print $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares in pairs (Diagram 1). Press seams toward plum prints. Join pairs to make a Four-Patch block (Diagram 2). Press seams in one direction. The Four-Patch block should be $8\frac{1}{2}$ " square including seam allowances. Repeat to make five Four-Patch blocks total.

Assemble Quilt Center

- 1. Referring to Quilt Assembly
 Diagram, lay out blocks and
 assorted green print 8½" setting
 squares in three rows.
- 2. Sew together pieces in each row. Press seams toward setting squares.
- **3.** Join rows to make quilt center. Press seams in one direction.

Add Border

- 1. Referring to Quilt Assembly
 Diagram, sew together two
 green print 4½×8½" rectangles,
 a pink print 4½" square, and a
 plum print 4½" square to make a
 short border strip. Press seams
 in one direction. Repeat to make
 a second short border strip.
- 2. Sew together two green print 4½×8½" rectangles, a pink print 4½" square, and three assorted plum print 4½" squares to make a long border strip. Press seams toward green print rectangles. Repeat to make a second long border strip.
- Sew short border strips to opposite edges of quilt center. Add long border strips to remaining edges to complete quilt top. Press all seams toward border.

Finish Ouilt


- **1.** Layer quilt top, batting, and backing; baste. Quilt as desired.
- **2.** Bind with plum print binding strips.
