
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Project: Checkerboard Nine-Patch

INSPIRED BY SUMMER SALSA FROM DESIGNER KATHIE HOLLAND QUILTMAKER: LAURA BOEHNKE





Nine-Patch blocks in two colorways and setting squares in bold prints give this throw a mod vibe.
Fabrics are from the Berkeley collection by Alice Kennedy for Timeless Treasures Fabrics (ttfabrics.com).

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Materials

- 5/8 yard pink floral (blocks)
- ¾ yard mottled yellow (blocks)
- 1/4 yard purple floral (blocks)
- 1½ yards purple paisley (setting squares, setting and corner triangles, binding)
- % yard white floral (setting squares)
- ½ yard mottled pink (setting squares)
- 31/3 yards backing fabric
- 60×68" batting

Finished quilt: 51½×60" Finished block: 6" square

Quantities are for 44/45"-wide, 100% cotton fabrics.

Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Cut Fabrics

Cut pieces in the following order.

From pink floral, cut:

■ 8-2**½**×42" strips

From mottled yellow, cut:

■ 10-2**½**×42" strips

From purple floral, cut:

■ 3-2**½**×42" strips

From purple paisley, cut:

- 6-2**½**×42" binding strips
- 6—9¾" squares, cutting each diagonally twice in an X for 24 setting triangles total (you will use 22)
- 18—6½" setting squares
- 2—5½" squares, cutting each in half diagonally for 4 corner triangles total

From white floral, cut:

■ 14-61/2" setting squares

From mottled pink, cut:

■ 12—6½" setting squares

Assemble Blocks

- 1. Referring to Diagram 1, sew together two pink floral 2½×42" strips and one mottled yellow 2½×42" strip to make strip set A. Press seams toward pink floral strips. Repeat to make three total of strip set A. Cut strip sets into 44—2½"-wide A segments.
- 2. Referring to Diagram 2, sew together two mottled yellow 2½x42" strips and one pink floral 2½x42" strip to make strip set B. Press seams toward pink floral. Repeat to make a second strip set B. Cut strip sets into 22—2½"-wide B segments.
- 3. Referring to Diagram 3, sew together two A segments and one B segment to make a Nine-Patch block. Press seams in one direction. The block should be 6½" square including seam allowances. Repeat to make 22 pink-and-yellow Nine-Patch blocks total.
- 4. Repeat steps 1–3 with purple floral strips and remaining mottled yellow strips to make six purple-and-yellow Nine-Patch blocks total.

Assemble Quilt Top

- 1. Referring to Quilt Assembly
 Diagram, lay out pink-and-yellow
 and purple-and-yellow NinePatch Blocks, white floral setting
 squares, mottled pink setting
 squares, and purple paisley
 setting squares and setting
 triangles in 12 diagonal rows.
- 2. Sew together pieces in each row. Press seams toward setting squares. Join rows; press seams in one direction. Add purple paisley corner triangles to complete quilt center. Press seams toward corner triangles.

Finish Quilt

- **1.** Layer quilt top, batting, and backing; baste. Quilt as desired.
- **2.** Bind with purple paisley binding strips.

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
