

PROJECT: Makeup Remover Rounds

DESIGNER: Elizabeth Stumbo

FINISHED SIZE: 3" diameter

MATERIALS

FOR 10 MAKEUP REMOVER ROUNDS

- Scraps of assorted prints
- Scraps of terry cloth towel, flannel, or old T-shirts

CUT FABRICS

Circle Pattern is *below*.

Circles can be cut with an AccuQuilt GO! fabric cutter using the GO! Circle-2", 3", 5" Die (#55012)

From assorted prints, cut:

- 10 of Circle Pattern

From towel, flannel, or T-shirt, cut:

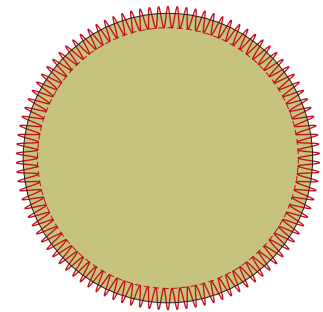
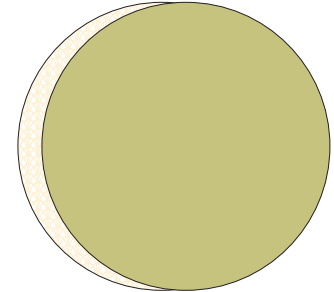
- 10 of Circle Pattern

ASSEMBLE MAKEUP REMOVER ROUNDS

1 Layer an assorted print circle and a towel, flannel, or T-shirt circle with wrong sides together (**Makeup Remover Rounds Assembly Diagram**); pin.

2 Using a 5-millimeter-wide and 1-millimeter-long overcasting or zigzag stitch, sew edges of layered circles to complete one makeup remover round.

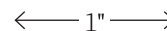
3 Repeat steps 1 and 2 to make 10 makeup remover rounds total.



Makeup Remover Rounds Assembly Diagram
