

MATERIALS

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

- 50—2½×42" strips and 1¾ yard assorted light prints or 5⅓ yards total assorted light prints (blocks, border)
- 70—2½×42" strips and 1¾ yard assorted medium and dark prints or 6⅞ yards total assorted medium and dark prints (blocks, binding)

on marked line. Press open to make two triangle-squares. Each triangle-square should be 2½" square including seam allowances. Repeat to make 448 triangle-squares total.

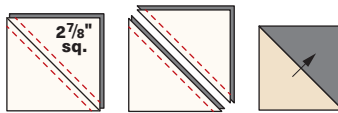

CUT FABRICS

Cut pieces in the following order.

From assorted light prints, cut:

- 224—2⅞" squares (or 3" squares if you like to oversize your triangle-squares and trim them to size)
- 768—2½" squares


From assorted medium and light prints, cut:

- 224—2⅞" squares (or 3" squares if you like to oversize your triangle-squares and trim them to size)
- Enough 2½"-wide strips in lengths ranging from 10" to 35" to total 400" for binding
- 896—2½" squares

ASSEMBLE BLOCKS

Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Press seams in directions indicated by arrows on diagrams. If no direction is specified, press seam toward darker fabric.

1 Use a pencil to mark a diagonal line  on wrong side of each light print 2⅞" square.

2 Layer a marked light print square atop a medium or dark print 2⅞" square. Sew together with two seams, stitching ¼" on each side of marked line (**Diagram 1**). Cut apart
