

Seasonal Sampler: Ice Skate Block

Find all block patterns and details about this quilt at AllPeopleQuilt.com/SeasonalSampler.

If you're making the *Seasonal Sampler*, you'll need two Ice Skate blocks.

FINISHED BLOCK: 12" square

MATERIALS

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

- 10" square solid white
- 9x21" piece (fat eighth) *each* blue print and dark gray print

CUT FABRICS

Cut pieces in the following order.

From solid white, cut:

- 1-1½x7½" strip
- 1-4½x5½" rectangle
- 1-2½" square
- 2-1½x2" rectangles

From blue print, cut:

- 1-6½x12½" rectangle
- 1-4½x7½" rectangle

From dark gray print, cut:

- 1-1½x12½" strip
- 2-1½" squares

ASSEMBLE BLOCK

Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Press seams in directions indicated by arrows on diagrams. If no direction is specified, press seam toward darker fabric.

1 Use a pencil to mark a diagonal line on wrong side of solid white 2½" square.

2 Align marked solid white 2½" square with top right-hand corner of blue print 6½x12½" rectangle (**Diagram 1**; note direction of marked line). Sew on marked line. Trim seam allowance to ¼". Press open attached triangle to make ice skate unit. The unit still should be 6½x12½" including seam allowances.

3 Referring to **Diagram 2**, lay out blue print 4½x7½" rectangle, solid white 4½x5½" rectangle, ice skate unit, solid white 1½x2" rectangles, dark gray print 1½" squares, solid white 1½x7½" strip, and dark gray print 1½x12½" strip in four rows. Sew together pieces in first and third rows. Join rows to make an Ice Skate block. The block should be 12½" square including seam allowances.

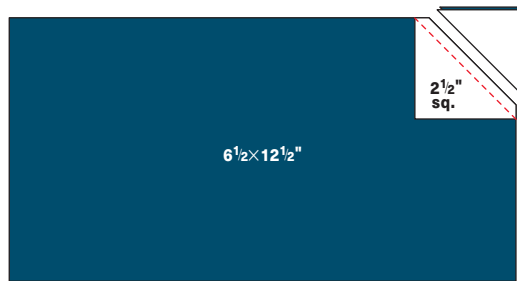

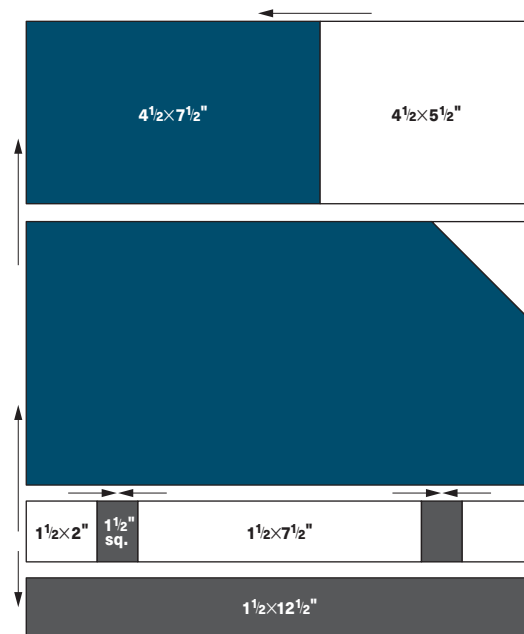
