

Seasonal Sampler: Tree Block

Find all block patterns and details about this quilt at AllPeopleQuilt.com/SeasonalSampler.

If you're making the *Seasonal Sampler*, you'll need two Tree blocks.

FINISHED BLOCK: 6x12"

MATERIALS

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

- 9x21" piece (fat eighth) *each* solid white and green print
- 5" square dark gray print

CUT FABRICS

Cut pieces in the following order.

From solid white, cut:

- 6-3½" squares
- 2-3x3½" rectangles

From green print, cut:

- 3-3½x6½" rectangles


From dark gray print, cut:

- 1-1½x3½" rectangle


ASSEMBLE BLOCK


Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Press seams in directions indicated by arrows on diagrams. If no direction is specified, press seam toward darker fabric.

1 Use a pencil to mark a diagonal line  on wrong side of each solid white 3½" square.

2 Align a marked solid white 3½" square with one end of a green print 3½x6½" rectangle (**Diagram 1**; note direction of marked line). Sew on marked line. Trim seam allowance to ¼". Press open attached triangle. Add a marked solid white 3½" square to opposite end of rectangle to make a Flying Geese unit. The unit still should be 3½x6½" including seam allowances. Repeat to make three Flying Geese units total.

3 Referring to **Diagram 2**, sew together  solid white 3x3½" rectangles and dark gray print 1½x3½" rectangle to make tree trunk unit. The unit should be 3½x6½" square including seam allowances.

4 Referring to **Diagram 3**, lay out Flying  Geese units and tree trunk unit in a row. Sew together pieces in row to make a Tree block. The block should be 6½x12½" including seam allowances.

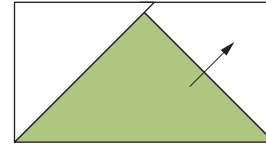
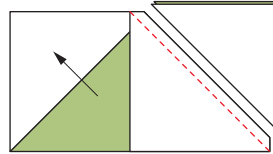
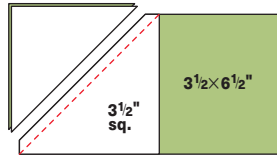


Diagram 1

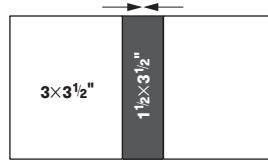

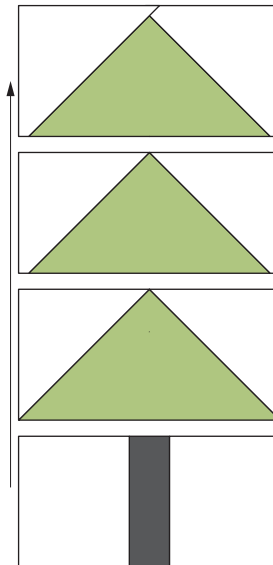
