

Seasonal Sampler: Snowman Block

Find all block patterns and details about this quilt at AllPeopleQuilt.com/SeasonalSampler.

If you're making the *Seasonal Sampler*, you'll need two Snowman blocks.

FINISHED BLOCK: 6x12"

MATERIALS

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

- 10" square solid white
- 5" square *each* blue print and red print
- 9x21" piece (fat eighth) aqua print

CUT FABRICS

Cut pieces in the following order.

From solid white, cut:

- 2-1 $\frac{1}{4}$ x5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
- 2-2 $\frac{1}{4}$ x2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
- 8-1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

From blue print, cut:

- 1-1x5" rectangle
- 1-2 $\frac{1}{2}$ x3" rectangle

From aqua print, cut:

- 1-5x5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle
- 1-1 $\frac{1}{2}$ x5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle
- 1-4 $\frac{1}{2}$ x5" rectangle
- 1-1x4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

From red print, cut:

- 1-1x5" rectangle
- 1-1x1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

ASSEMBLE BLOCK

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Press seams in directions indicated by arrows on diagrams. If no direction is specified, press seam toward darker fabric.

1 Referring to **Diagram 1**, sew together solid white 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ x2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles and blue print 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ x3" rectangle to make a hat unit. The unit should be 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ x6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " including seam allowances.

2 Use a pencil to mark a diagonal line on wrong side of each solid white 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

3 Align four marked solid white squares with each corner of an aqua print 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ x5" rectangle (**Diagram 2**; note direction of drawn lines). Sew on marked lines. Trim seam allowances to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press open attached triangles to make a Snowball unit. The unit still should be 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ x5" including seam allowances.

4 Referring to **Diagram 3**, sew blue print 1x5" rectangle and red print 1x5" rectangle to long edges of Snowball unit. Add solid white 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ x5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles to remaining edges to make a head unit. The unit should be 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ x6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " including seam allowances.

5 Align two marked solid white squares with top left-hand and bottom left-hand corners on a long edge of aqua print 5x5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle (**Diagram 4**; note direction of drawn lines). Sew on marked lines. Trim seam allowances to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press open attached triangles to make a left body unit. The unit still should be 5x5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " including seam allowances.

6 Referring to **Diagram 5**, sew together red print 1x1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle and aqua print 1x4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to make a scarf unit. The unit should be 1x5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " including seam allowances.

7 Align two remaining marked solid white squares with each end of an aqua print 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ x5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle (**Diagram 6**; note direction of drawn lines). Sew on marked lines. Trim seam allowances to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press open attached triangles to make a right body unit. The unit still should be 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ x5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " including seam allowances.

8 Referring to **Diagram 7**, sew together left body unit, scarf unit, and right body unit to make a body unit. The unit should be 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ x6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " including seam allowances.

9 Referring to **Diagram 8**, lay out hat unit, head unit, and body unit in a row. Sew together pieces in row to make a Snowman block. The block should be 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ x12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " including seam allowances.

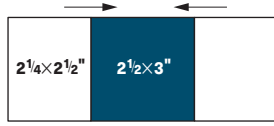

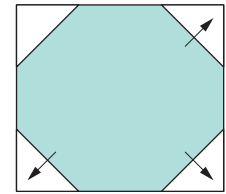
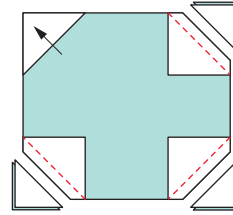
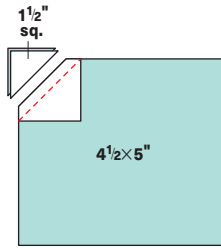

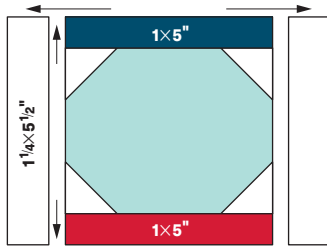

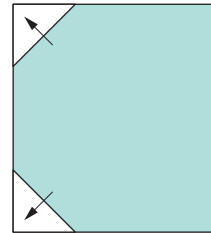
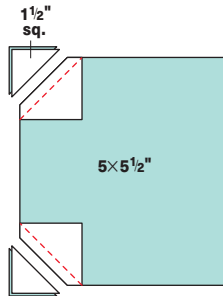

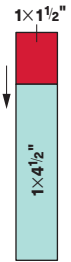

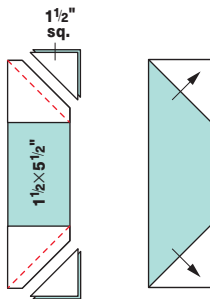

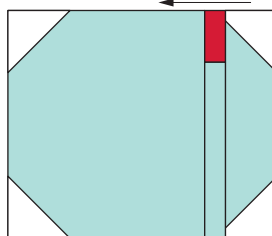

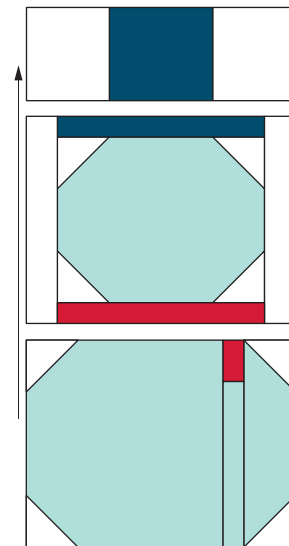
