

Seasonal Sampler: Ice Skate Block

This is a bonus 6" block version of the Ice Skate Block. Find all block patterns and details about this quilt at AllPeopleQuilt.com/SeasonalSampler.

FINISHED BLOCK: 6" square

MATERIALS

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

- 10" square *each* solid white, blue print, and dark gray print

CUT FABRICS

Cut pieces in the following order.

From solid white, cut:

- 1-1×3½" strip
- 1-2½×3" rectangle
- 1-1½" square
- 2-1×1½" rectangles

From blue print, cut:

- 1-3½×6½" rectangle
- 1-2½×4" rectangle

From dark gray print, cut:

- 1-1×6½" strip
- 2-1" squares

ASSEMBLE BLOCK

Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Press seams in directions indicated by arrows on diagrams. If no direction is specified, press seam toward darker fabric.

1 Use a pencil to mark a diagonal line on wrong side of solid white 1½" square.

2 Align marked solid white 1½" square with top right-hand corner of blue print 3½×6½" rectangle (**Diagram 1**; note direction of marked line). Sew on marked line. Trim seam allowance to ¼". Press open attached triangle to make ice skate unit. The unit still should be 3½×6½" including seam allowances.

3 Referring to **Diagram 2**, lay out blue print 2½×4" rectangle, solid white 2½×3" rectangle, ice skate unit, solid white 1×1½" rectangles, dark gray print 1" squares, solid white 1×3½" strip, and dark gray print 1×6½" strip in four rows. Sew together pieces in first and third rows. Join rows to make an Ice Skate block. The block should be 6½" square including seam allowances.

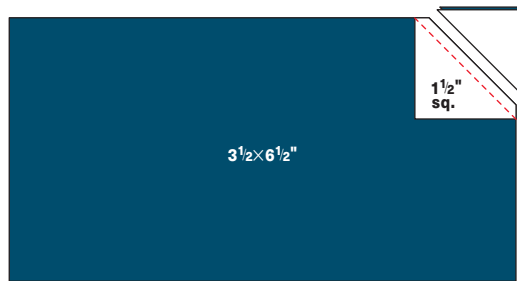

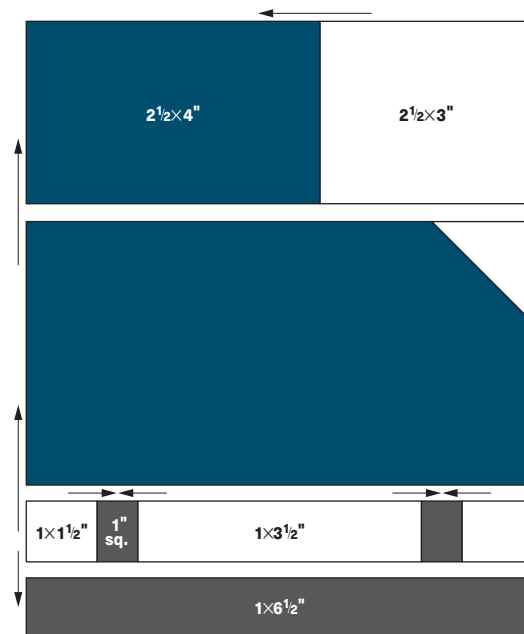
