

Seasonal Sampler: Mug Block

This is a bonus 6" block version of the Mug block. Find all block patterns and details about this quilt at AllPeopleQuilt.com/SeasonalSampler.

FINISHED BLOCK: 6" square

MATERIALS

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

- 10" square *each* solid white and red print

CUT FABRICS

Cut pieces in the following order.

From red print, cut:

- 1-5x5½" rectangle
- 1-1x2½" rectangle
- 2-1x2" rectangles

From solid white, cut:

- 1-2x2½" rectangle
- 1-1½x5" rectangle
- 1-1½x2½" rectangle
- 1-1½x2" rectangle

ASSEMBLE BLOCK

Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Press seams in directions indicated by arrows on diagrams. If no direction is specified, press seam toward darker fabric.

1 Referring to **Diagram 1**, sew together red print 1x2½" rectangle and solid white 1½x2½" rectangle to make a pieced unit. The unit should be 2x2½" including seam allowances.

2 Referring to **Diagram 2**, lay out solid white 2x2½" rectangle, red print 1x2" rectangles, pieced unit, solid white 1½x2" rectangle, solid white 1½x5" rectangle, and red print 5x5½" rectangle in two vertical rows. Sew together pieces in rows. Join rows to make a Mug block. The block should be 6½" square including seam allowances.

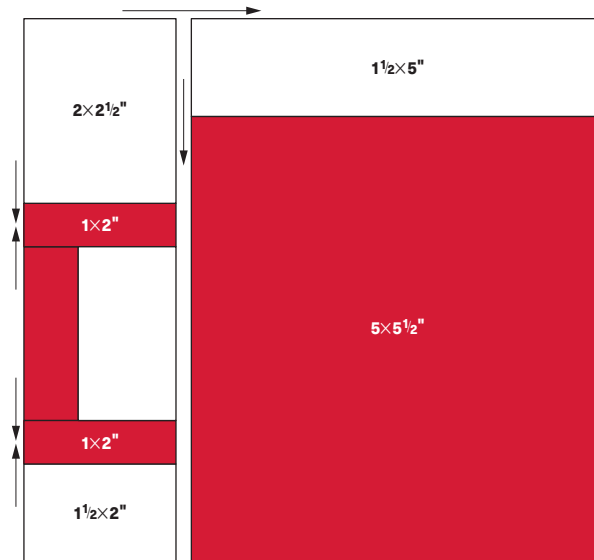
