

## Seasonal Sampler: Star Block

If you're making the *Seasonal Sampler*, you'll need three Star blocks.

**FINISHED BLOCK:** 6" square

### MATERIALS

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

- 10" square *each* solid white and blue print
- 5" square *each* aqua print and green print

### CUT FABRICS

Cut pieces in the following order.

#### From solid white, cut:

- 4-2×3½" rectangles
- 4-2" squares

#### From aqua print, cut:

- 2-2" squares

#### From green print, cut:

- 2-2" squares


#### From blue print, cut:

- 8-2" squares


### ASSEMBLE BLOCK


Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Press seams in directions indicated by arrows on diagrams. If no direction is specified, press seam toward darker fabric.

**1** Use a pencil to mark a diagonal line on  wrong side of each blue print 2" square.

**2** Align a marked blue print 2" square with one end of a solid white 2×3½" rectangle (**Diagram 1**; note direction of marked line). Sew on marked line. Trim seam allowance to ¼". Press open attached triangle. Add a marked blue print 2" square to opposite end of rectangle to make a Flying Geese unit. The unit still should be 2×3½" including seam allowances. Repeat to make four Flying Geese units total.

**3** Referring to **Diagram 2**, sew together  aqua print and green print 2" squares in pairs. Join pairs to make a Four-Patch unit. The unit should be 3½" square including seam allowances.

**4** Referring to **Diagram 3**, lay out solid  white 2" squares, Flying Geese units, and Four-Patch unit in three rows. Sew together pieces in rows. Join rows to make a Star block. The block should be 6½" square including seam allowances.
