

Seasonal Sampler: Finishing

Find all block patterns and details about this quilt at AllPeopleQuilt.com/SeasonalSampler.

FINISHED QUILT: 66½×80½"

MATERIALS

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

- 1¼ yards solid white
- 1 yard pink print
- ⅔ yard binding fabric
- 5 yards backing fabric
- 75×89" batting

CUT FABRICS

Cut pieces in the following order.

From solid white, cut:

- 12–2½×42" strips for sashing and inner border
- 15–2½×12½" sashing rectangles

From pink print, cut:

- 7–4½×42" strips for outer border

From binding fabric, cut:

- 8–2½×42" binding strips

ASSEMBLE ROW 1

Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Press seams in directions indicated by arrows on diagrams. If no direction is specified, press seam toward darker fabric.

1 Referring to **Quilt Assembly Diagram, Row 1**, lay out one Present block, three solid white 2½×12½" sashing rectangles, one Wreath block, one Tree block, one Snowman block, and one Mug block.

2 Join Tree block and Snowman block; press seam open.

3 To make Row 1, sew together blocks and sashing rectangles; press seams toward sashing rectangles. The row should be 12½×54½" including seam allowances.

ASSEMBLE ROW 2

1 Referring to **Quilt Assembly Diagram, Row 1**, lay out one Santa Hat block, three solid white 2½×12½" sashing rectangles, one Peppermint block, one Ornament block, one Star block, one Stocking block, and one Ice Skate block.

2 Join Ornament block and Star block; press seam open.

3 Join Step 2 pieced unit to bottom of Peppermint block; press seam open.

4 To make Row 2, sew together blocks and sashing rectangles; press seams toward sashing rectangles. The row should be 12½×54½" including seam allowances.

ASSEMBLE ROW 3

1 Referring to **Quilt Assembly Diagram, Row 1**, lay out one Mitten block, three solid white 2½×12½" sashing rectangles, one Present block, one Mug block, two Ornament blocks, and one Tree block.

2 Join two Ornament blocks; press seam open.

3 Join Step 2 pieced unit to left-hand side of Tree block; press seam open.

4 To make Row 3, sew together blocks and sashing rectangles; press seams toward sashing rectangles. The row should be 12½×54½" including seam allowances.

ASSEMBLE ROW 4

1 Referring to **Quilt Assembly Diagram, Row 1**, lay out one Snowman block, one Peppermint block, three solid white 2½×12½" sashing rectangles, one Ice Skate block, one Wreath block, and one Mitten block.

2 Join Snowman block and Peppermint block; press seam open.

3 To make Row 4, sew together blocks and sashing rectangles; press seams toward sashing rectangles. The row should be 12½×54½" including seam allowances.

ASSEMBLE ROW 5

1 Referring to **Quilt Assembly Diagram, Row 1**, lay out one Ice Skate block, three solid white 2½×12½" sashing rectangles, one Santa Hat block, two Star blocks, two Ornament blocks, and one Present block.

2 Join Star blocks and Ornament blocks in pairs; press seams open.

3 Join Step 2 pairs; press seam open.

4 To make Row 5, sew together blocks and sashing rectangles; press seams toward sashing rectangles. The row should be 12½×54½" including seam allowances.

ASSEMBLE QUILT TOP

1 Piece and cut solid white 2½×42" strips to make:

- 2–2½×68½" inner border strips
- 2–2½×58½" inner border strips
- 4–2½×54½" sashing strips

2 Referring to **Quilt Assembly Diagram**, sew together rows and solid white 2½×54½" sashing strips to complete quilt center. Press seams toward sashing strips. The quilt center should be 54½×68½" including seam allowances.

3 Sew long inner border strips to long edges of quilt center. Add short inner border strips to remaining edges. Press seams toward inner border.

4 Piece and cut pink print $4\frac{1}{2}\times 42$ " strips to make:

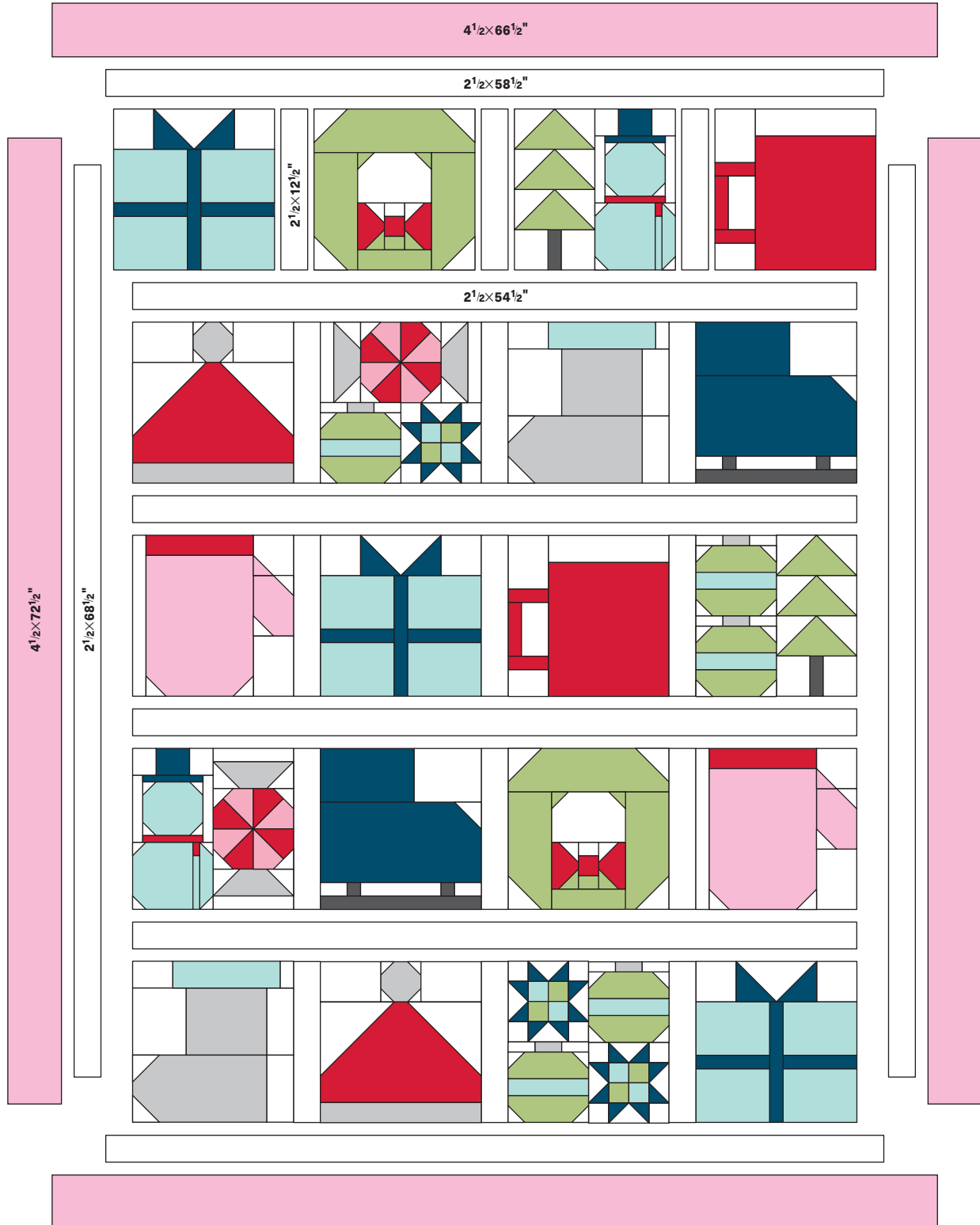
- 2- $4\frac{1}{2}\times 72\frac{1}{2}$ " outer border strips
- 2- $4\frac{1}{2}\times 66\frac{1}{2}$ " outer border strips

5 Sew long outer border strips to long edges of quilt center. Add short outer border strips to remaining edges to complete quilt top. Press seams toward outer border.

FINISH QUILT

1 Layer quilt top, batting, and backing; baste. Quilt as desired.

2 Bind with $2\frac{1}{2}\times 42$ " binding strips.
